GENERAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show. A copy of the General Regulations can be obtained from the Society's website at www.theshow.com.au or from the Society's Administration Office.

Exhibitors should note that the General Regulations contain a number of provisions relevant to competitions and this Schedule including but not limited to, offences, penalties, prohibited drugs. As those conditions apply in addition to the regulations contained within this schedule, Exhibitors should familiarise themselves with the General Regulations.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Special Regulations contained within this Schedule are merely supplementary to and subject to the General Regulations.

The members of the Society's Rural Services Division shall have the authority to act on behalf of the Society to take any necessary action under these Special Regulations.

YOUNG JUDGES CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1. The **SA YOUNG JUDGES CHAMPIONSHIP** is open to <u>South Australian residents only,</u> and Agricultural Societies Council subject to the following:
- a) i) In order to represent South Australia, competitors must be over 15 years and under 25 years on 1 May in the year of their state competition.
- ii) The highest placed South Australian entrant is eligible for the next National Final.
- b) In order to represent SA at the National Finals, competitors must reside in South Australia for three months prior to the start of the Royal Adelaide Show.
- c) If a competitor wins a National Final, they are ineligible to compete again in that competition.
- d) If a competitor wins a State Championship or represents SA at the National Finals they are ineligible to be a place getter at State level prior to competing at nationals.
- 2. Each contestant must be in attendance and have reported to the Convener at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled competition time.

3. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE CHARGED.

- 4. Score cards will be as provided by the Royal Agricultural & Horticultural Society of SA Inc.
- 5. Competitors will not be allowed to retain Judging Cards.
- 6. The decision of the Judge will be final.
- 7. Comments on the competition are at the discretion of the Judge.
- 8. No contestant may accept advice during judging from sources other than designated Officials. The use of any electronic device is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Contestants are to obey instructions.
- 10. Presentation of trophies will follow the judging of each class.
- 11. Competitors must be neatly and appropriately attired with closed footwear suitable for handling livestock.

National Finals State Representative

National finals will be held in the following areas: Beef, Beef Paraders, Meat Sheep, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Cattle Handlers, Merino Sheep, Merino Fleece, Poultry and Alpacas.

The State Champion winner will be eligible to represent the state in the National Young Judges Championship if they are over 15 years and under 25 years on 1 May in the year of their state competition. If they are under 15 the highest placed competitor who meets the age requirement will be chosen as the State's Representative.

The national final is held the following year during the nominated state's Royal Show. The winner (if the national final is interstate and they meet the Agricultural Society Council of SA criteria) will receive a return airfare to the National Judging Championship and two nights accommodation.

If the winner is under 18 years of age, they must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver at their own cost.

The National Final Representative will also receive a blazer and shirt from Marino Uniforms, a tie or scarf from Agricultural Societies Council of SA Inc (SA Country Shows) and a badge from J Francis.

PRIZES

Prizes in each class (unless otherwise specified) will be: First, \$25 and ribbon; second, \$10 and ribbon; third, ribbon PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID BY THE END OF OCTOBER

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

All prize money won during the Royal Adelaide Show will be paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) only.

PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID BY THE END OF OCTOBER.

The Society makes every endeavour to ensure all prizes listed are accurate at the time of publishing. Should a cash prize be withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing, the prize will revert back to the competitions default amount where applicable. Vouchers, product or trophies withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing will not be replaced. It is the responsibility of the prize winner to follow-up with the Society any sponsored prize (cash, voucher, product, trophy) they believe they are entitled to prior to 30 November in the year of the prize being awarded. The Society will not follow-up prize sponsors after this date or review any prizes that may have been incorrectly awarded.

PRIZE MONEY AND GST

Prize money as stated in the Prize Schedule does not include GST.

The prize money which we pay to successful exhibitors depends on information provided to us. If you confirm that you are GST registered and provide your Australian Business Number (ABN), we will pay the appropriate prize money plus 10% GST. We will provide you with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice which you will need to submit to the Australian Taxation Office.

If you confirm you are registered for GST, in entering the competition, you acknowledge your agreement to the following:

- You will not issue a tax invoice to the RA&HS in respect to prize money received;
- You will notify the RA&HS if you cease to be registered for GST.

If you provide your Australian Business Number but are not registered for GST, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Prize Schedule without reference to the GST.

If you confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Prize Schedule without reference to GST.

IMPORTANT

It is important that you either:

- · Confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, or
- · Confirm you are entering as a GST registered business and supply your ABN

Failure to do either of the above will cause the RA&HS to withhold 48.5% of your prize money in accordance with Australian tax legislation.

The RA&HS is not a tax consultant and therefore assumes no liability for actions taken as a result of these guidelines. In any instances where an entrant or sponsor is uncertain of the tax implications of their involvement, they should consult their own accountant or tax advisor.
