Marco Lepasaar (Estonia)



Since childhood Marko always had dogs. They were hunting dogs like Spaniels and Dachshunds. Marko and his wife Siret's kennel name is ALDERISLAND. They have together bred Dalmatians and Basset Fauve de Bretagne's for many years. Today they have at home Basset Fauve De Bretagne, Tibetan Terrier, Chihuahua and Whippet. Over the past 20 years Marko has been involved in organizing over 150 different dog shows in Estonia (Speciality shows, National all breeds and International shows). Marko is also Chairman of Estonian Kennel Union Show Committee and Judges Committee. He has licence to judge all breeds. Marko has judged in 50 FCI countries and he judged WW-16 in Moscow and EW-17 in Kiev, WW-17 in Lepzig, WW-18 in Amsterdam and EW-18 in Warsaw, The Americas and the Caribbean Winner -19 in Mexico, WW-20 in Madrid, EW-21 in Budapest and EW-22 in Paris.

From childhood on I always had dogs in my family. They were hunting dogs, like Russian hounds. My first dalmatian joined us in 1998. She was a liverspotted dalmatian bitch Bella. Thanks to her I started to visit dog shows and became friends with so many nice people from all over Europe. Because of her Dalmatians will have a special place in my heart forever.

Our kennel ALDERISLAND (it's our family name LEPASAAR translated to English) produced the first Dalmatian litter in 2001. Since 2005 we have also bred Basset Fauve De Bretagne's (BFDB). We have bred several good-looking Dalmatians and BFDB-s with a nice temperament and we are very happy that all of our puppies have loving families.

We have achieved a great deal of success with BFDBs (some European Winners and Junior World Winners). Today we have at home BFDBs, Tibetan Terriers, Chihuahuas and Whippets.

My involvement with purebred dogs began in the late 1970's, when I met my wife of over 40 years, 2 Great Danes were part of the deal. We bred and exhibited Great Danes successfully, owning and breeding Best in Show winners until the mid 90's, when English Foxhounds started to take over the kennel. Since then we have bred and owned Best in Show, Royal Group winning & Record breaking English Foxhounds & Harriers. We have bred or owned over 47 champions in these breeds. In recent years hounds from our kennel Foxhunt have been exported to the USA, Europe and New Zealand.

My three daughters also breed and exhibit dogs and through them I have had a direct involvement in Beagles, Boxers, Shar Pei, Siberian Huskies, Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks and more recently Dobermanns. All of those breeds have enjoyed considerable success. I have been involved with club Management for many of the years I have been involved in conformation showing

and I am President of Medowie ABKC, Vice President of Liverpool ABKC, Secretary of Bay City ABKC, as well as Show Secretary for many other clubs. I also serve on the boar at Dogs NSW. I am privileged to be a Councillor at the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW where my main role currently is Chairman of Domestic Animals, a role which enables me the great honour of overseeing the organisation and successful execution of one of Australia's largest and most prestigious shows The Sydney Royal Dog Show.

My Judging career commenced in 1989 and since then I have been lucky enough to have judged in all states of Australia, overseas in Finland, The Philippines, Indonesia, Canada, The USA, Japan and extensively in New Zealand. For the last 20 years, I have been involved in publishing. Our company Top Dog Media produces canine publications including Dog News Australia of which I am Editor-in-chief. Over two decades it has enabled me to see dogs in depth from Australia, Asia and in fact the world. As part of my work with Top Dog Media I wrote the best-selling book The Concise Australian Dog Judges Guide, which has now had four editions and been eagerly sought after by judges all over the world. I look forward to expanding my horizons and judging some wonderful dogs at the Adelaide Royal Show

I have been involved in the world of dogs for over 50 years. My main involvement has been with Bullmastiffs and Shiba Inu. I have been lucky enough to both own and handle some top quality Bullmastiffs. Over the last 25 years I have successfully bred and exhibited Shiba Inu under the Kazumi prefix, breeding and owning Shibas that have reached BIS level. Other breeds with which I have some involvement include Whippets, Setters and French Bulldogs, Shih Tzu and Labradors.

I have been judging at Championship Show level for over 35 years, and I am licensed to Judge All Breeds. Judging dogs is an absolute passion for me, and I learn more every day through judging, discussions, considerations and contemplations.

I have judged extensively throughout Australia, together with New Zealand, many countries throughout Asia, The Americas, UK and several countries in Europe. Highlights include awarding CCs to Bullmastiffs in the UK, judging the Bullmastiff World Cup in Budapest, Hungary and in 2014, and again in France in 2019. I had the pleasure of judging several breeds at the 2014 Helsinki World Dog Show. I was honoured to judge the FCI Asia Section Show in Seoul 2019, invited to judge the Caribbean and Americas Section in 2020, and judged the 2022 European Dog Show in France and the 2024 European Dog Show in Slovenia.

I am past Chairman and current Committee member of the great Melbourne Royal – which conducts Melbourne Royal Show each year, one of the largest Dog Shows both in Australia and the Southern Hemisphere. I am also Chairman of The Classic Dog Show Committee in Victoria, and Chairman of the Dogs Australia National Bullmastiff Breed Council.

I am a past Trainee Judges Manager for the Non-Sporting, Utility and Hound groups in Victoria, and an accredited Tester in the Dogs Australia Judges Training Scheme for all breeds. I am a member of the Dogs Victoria Conformation Judges Training Committee and the Dogs Victoria Colour Investigation Panel. I am a schoolteacher by profession, working in the secondary education public sector. It will be a pleasure to return to Japan.

MEMBERSHIP

Exhibitors need not be members of the Royal Agricultural & Horticultural Society of SA Inc, but members are entitled to a reduced entry fee in the Royal Adelaide Show.

Membership fees: Adults \$198, Juniors \$72 (under 18). Membership of other Royal Show Societies does not entitle exhibitors to a reduced rate of entry fees for the Royal Adelaide Show.

Please Note:

South Australian exhibitors must be financial members of Dogs SA. Interstate Exhibitors must be financial members of their Controlling Bodies in the State or Territory where they reside.

Entries received from non-members and unfinancial members will not be accepted.

WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawals must be made in writing and can be sent via email

to entries@adelaideshowground.com.au. Withdrawals must include "Withdrawal" in the subject line and the section (e.g. Dog section), Exhibitor name, class number/s, exhibit number (if known) and exhibit name (if applicable). Withdrawals must be made at least 24 hours prior to judging.

REFUNDS

No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries. Entry fees are payable and are not refundable in the event of the Exhibit being withdrawn, disqualified, merged classes or the competition cancelled unless otherwise specified by the RA&HS.

In the event that the competition as a whole is cancelled by the Society, all entry fees will be reimbursed in full.

TRANSFER

If an exhibit is entered in an incorrect class, (other than the wrong sex) whether through fault of the intending exhibitor or his agent or otherwise, it shall not be transferred to the correct class after the closing of entries nor shall any refund of entry or registration or other fees be made, but the exhibit shall, if eligible for the open class, be transferred to that class.

If any other inadvertent error or omission is made on the entry form, the entrant may be permitted, at the discretion of the Society, to make corrections.

REGISTRATION

Prior to entry, all dogs must be registered with their Canine Controlling in the State or Territory, in which the owner resides and officially transferred to present ownership.

Completed registration details to be provided as soon as possible. The Baby Puppy will be ineligible to be exhibited if details are not provided prior to the first day of exhibition.

LOCATION

The Dog Pavilions are located in the North-Western corner of the Showground.

Only dogs accepted for competition shall be brought onto the Showground.

Dogs must enter the Showground via the Cooke Terrace Gate off Greenhill Road.

Cooke Terrace Gate will be open from 7.30 am daily.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

It is a condition of entry that the arrival and departure times set out below will be adhered to.

Any attempt to deliver or remove exhibits outside of these times, will not be possible.

Dogs may enter the Showground from 7.30 am and must be benched by 8.30 am, ready for judging at 9.00 am on every day of judging.

Exhibitor entry via gate 1A is strictly limited from 7.30 am to 9.00 am. Any notifications of late arrivals must be received by 8.30 am by calling the Show Manager (Dogs) on 0447 227 565. Acceptance will be at the discretion of the Dog Committee.

All dogs benched must be brought before the judge for decision.

REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

Dogs will be permitted to leave at 5.00 pm each day.

Dogs will be permitted to leave before the stipulated time only with the approval of the Committee and only in exceptional conditions.

Removal of dogs before the stipulated time of departure will render the exhibitor/s, handler/s, owner/s and dog/s liable to disqualification.

IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO STAY WITH YOUR DOG/S UNTIL THE STIPULATED TIME OF DEPARTURE, PLEASE DO NOT MAKE AN ENTRY.

ENTRY PASSES

- More than Six exhibits; one pass for every other two exhibits entered

An additional pass will be issued by the Show Manager to exhibitors returning for judging on Sunday 7 September. Resale of entry passes is not permitted.

CAR PARK TICKETS

Exhibitors will have exclusive use of Rose Terrace Car Parks 2 and 3.

Access for Dog exhibitors to Rose Terrace Car Park 2 will be through a designated Dog exhibitor entry from Rose Terrace. Exhibitors seeking to park a vehicle and a trailer will be directed to Rose Terrace Car Park 2. Bookings should be made with entries.

Cost: Single vehicles \$28, Vehicle & trailer \$56.

Accommodation will be made for parking for finals on Sunday 7 September and will be made available during the Show but will be restricted as there are only a certain number available. Not all major award winners will be able to be provided with a carpark.

JUNIOR HANDLER CLASSES

An Australian National Kennel Council Challenge Certificate/Best of Breed may be awarded in any breed at the discretion of the Judge. No award will be made unless the exhibit is, in the opinion of the Judge, worthy.

SPECIALS AWARDS - CONFORMATION JUDGING

- 1. Judging on Saturday 30 August to Saturday 6 September, will proceed as far as the awarding of "Best Neuter of Breed" "Best Baby Puppy", "Best Puppy of Breed", Best of Breed", "Runner-up Best of Breed".
- 2. Exhibits awarded "Best of Breed", "Puppy of Breed", "Best Neuter of Breed", "Baby Puppy of the Day" from each group, must attend and compete in Group Specials on General Specials Day, unless:
- a) A certificate signed by the owner is lodged with the Society advising that the animal has died, or
- b) The owner lodges with the Society a veterinary certificate certifying that the dog is unfit for exhibition due to injury or disease, or
- c) The owner advises of some other cause or reason why the dog cannot be exhibited and which the Society's

Dog Committee considers reasonable.

- 3. Group Specials will be judged on Sunday 7 September at 9.00 am, beginning with Group 3, followed by 1, 2, 4, 6, 5, and 7.
- 4. All dogs and bitches eligible for Group Specials must be benched by 8.30 am on that day.
- 5. Benching for ALL Giant Breeds will be allocated on Sunday 7 September.

BEST OF BREED CERTIFICATES

Best of Breed Certificates awarded (including exhibits excused from exhibiting in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 2, a. to c. "Special Awards", previously) will be available for collection at the Dog Pavilion office on General Specials Day.

Certificates will not be available for "Best of Breed" winners not exhibited in Group Specials, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 2 above.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

Any prize money won during the Royal Adelaide Show is paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). The exhibitor should provide the BSB, Account Number and Account Name at time of original entry. PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID BY THE END OF OCTOBER.

PRIZE MONEY AND GST

Prize money as stated in the Prize Schedule does not include GST.

The prize money which we pay to successful exhibitors depends on information provided to us. If you confirm that you are GST registered and provide your Australian Business Number (ABN), we will pay the appropriate prize money plus 10% GST. We will provide you with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice which you will need to submit to the Australian Taxation Office.

If you confirm you are registered for GST, in entering the competition, you acknowledge your agreement to the following:

- You will not issue a tax invoice to the RA&HS in respect to prize money received;
- You will notify the RA&HS if you cease to be registered for GST.
- If you provide your ABN but are not registered for GST, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Prize Schedule without reference to the GST.
 - If you confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Prize Schedule without reference to GST.

IMPORTANT

It is important that you either:

- Confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, or
- Confirm you are entering as a GST registered business and supply your ABN

Failure to do either of the above will require the RA&HS to withhold tax, at the maximum tax rate, from your prize money in accordance with Australian tax legislation.

The RA&HS is not a tax consultant and therefore assumes no liability for actions taken as a result of these guidelines. In any instances where an entrant or sponsor is uncertain of the tax implications of their involvement, they should consult their own accountant or tax advisor.

The Society makes every endeavor to ensure all prizes listed are accurate at the time of publishing. Should a cash prize be withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing, the prize will revert back to the competitions default amount where applicable. Vouchers, product or trophies withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing will not be replaced. It is the responsibility of the prize winner to follow-up with the Society any sponsored prize (cash, voucher, product, trophy) they believe they are entitled to prior to 30 November in the year of the prize being awarded. The Society will not follow-up prize sponsors after this date or review any prizes that may have been incorrectly awarded..

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show. A copy of the General Regulations can be obtained from the Society's website at www.theshow.com.au or from the Society's Administration Office.

Exhibitors should note that the General Regulations contain a number of provisions relevant to competitions and this Schedule including but not limited to, offences, penalties, prohibited drugs. As those conditions apply in addition to the regulations contained within this schedule, Exhibitors should familiarise themselves with the General Regulations.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Special Regulations contained within this Schedule are merely supplementary to and subject to the General Regulations.

The members of the Society's Beef Cattle Committee shall have the authority to act on behalf of the Society to take any necessary action under these Special Regulations.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

A Member of the SACA or any interstate Canine Controlling Body, shall in the precincts of an Exhibition

- · Promptly clean up and remove all droppings left by any dog under their control; and
- Promptly clean up and remove all rubbish left by that Member/s

EXHIBITING

The only persons permitted to handle exhibits at any exhibition conducted by an affiliate of Dogs SA are:

- 1. Members of the Association; or
- 2. Members of Controlling bodies in the State or Territory in which the person is domiciled.

BENCHING

- 1. Exhibits will be placed and shall remain where directed by the Society's Pavilion Supervisor.
- 2. Exhibit numbers shall correspond with the bench or cage number allotted to the exhibit.
- 3. Different breeds or variety of breeds, although owned by the same exhibitor, will NOT be benched together.
- 4. Benching for ALL Giant Breeds will be allocated on General Specials Day.

Bench numbers must not be altered, moved or otherwise interfered with unless approved by the Dog Pavilion Supervisor. No exhibit shall be absent from its bench except with the approval of the Committee.

POWDER

The use of grooming powders/chalk inside the pavilion is not permitted other than in the designated grooming area.

LEADS

Dogs must be brought to the Showground secured with a suitable lead no longer than 2m and Owners/Handlers of exhibits shall always maintain control over exhibits during the Show.

EXERCISE PERIOD

Dogs may be exercised daily during the one-hour lunch break at a time to be determined each day, depending on the progress of judging.

The Dog Pavilion bench area will be closed during exercise periods.

Dogs must be exercised only in the designated areas.

DISPLAY CARDS

A display card, not exceeding 210 mm x 297 mm (A4 size), showing the dog's name, its breeder and/or exhibitor, may be placed over each exhibit.

No exhibitor will be allowed to display any prize card or ribbon on their exhibit, stall or stand, other than those issued or approved by the Society for the current year.

Any Signage must not exceed 50 cm x 20 cm.

Free standing signage, or any form of advertising/signage other than that described above, will not be permitted.

TROLLEYS AND GROOMING TABLES

Trolleys and grooming tables are to be kept within the boundary of the bench rails. They are not permitted to be kept in the walkways.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Baby Puppy Class

Is a class in which only dogs of 3 months and under 6 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete.

Puppy Class:

Is a class in which only dogs of 6 months and under 12 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete.

Junior Class:

Is a class in which dogs of 9 months and under 18 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete. Intermediate Class:

Is a class in which dogs of 18 months and under 36 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete. Australian Bred Class:

Is a class in which dogs whelped in Australia on or over the age of six months on the first day of Show are eligible to compete.

Open Class:

Is a class in which dogs six months of age or over on the first day of the Show.

Neuter Class:

Is a class in which dogs six months of age and over on the first day of the Show and are registered as a Neuter on the main register are eligible to compete.

BREED CLASSES

The age of exhibits is calculated to the first day of the Show i.e. Saturday 30 August 2025. DOGS

Class 1-Baby Puppy Dog, for Dogs whelped on or between 25/2/25 and 30/5/25

Class 3-Puppy Dog, for Dogs whelped on or between 30/8/24 and 28/2/25

Class 4-Junior Dog, for Dogs whelped on or between 28/2/24 and 30/11/2024

Class 5-Intermediate Dog, for Dogs whelped on or between 31/08/21 and 1/3/23

Class 10-Australian Bred Dog, for dogs over the age of six months whelped in Australia on or before 28/2/25

Class 11-Open Dog, for Dogs whelped on or before 28/02/25

Class 18 - Neuter Dog, for dogs over the age of six months whelped on or before 28/02/25 and are registered as a Neuter on the main register

BITCHES

Class 1a-Baby Puppy Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 25/2/25 and 30/5/25

Class 3a-Puppy Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 30/8/24 and 28/2/25

Class 4a–Junior Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 28/2/24 and 30/11/2024

Class 5a-Intermediate Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 1/08/21 and 1/3/23

Class 10a-Australian Bred Bitch, for dogs over the age of six months whelped in Australia on or before 28/2/25

Class 11a-Open Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or before 28/02/25

Class 18a - Neuter Bitch, for dogs over the age of six months whelped on or before 28/02/25 and are registered as a Neuter on the main register

INJURY, DISEASE

If in the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon a dog shall be so injured or be so affected by sickness, disease or other ailment as to warrant its removal, the Society shall be entitled to have the dog removed. Any expense incurred by the Society in respect of such dog shall be debited to the owner.

PROTESTS

Any protest must be lodged forthwith in writing and accompanied by a \$100 fee. All incidents to be reported within 24 hours to the Show Manager.

RESTRAINT OF DOGS AT ALL EXHIBITIONS

Except as necessary for the proper conduct of an Exhibition as provided in these Rules, all dogs shall wear a slip, an adjustable slip, or fixed collar and a lead no longer than two metres, unless being judged, and be in the control of a responsible person at all times. No dog shall wear a muzzle or head collar in the judging precinct. At an exhibition a head collar shall be attached to a slip or fixed collar."

JUDGING GUIDELINES

Sequence of Judging

As required by the ANKC Regulations the sequence of judging Best Exhibit in Group and Best Exhibit in Show awards shall be in the following order:

- 1. Best Exhibit in Group, placed in the order 4th, 3rd, 2nd, 1st.
- 2. Best Baby Puppy in Group
- 3. Best Puppy in Group
- 4. Best Neuter in Group
- 5. Best Neuter in Show
- 6. Best Baby Puppy in Show
- 7. Best Puppy in Show
- 8. Best Exhibit in Show, placed in the order 2nd, 1st

ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 5, Section 5 (effective 1 July 2017)

5.3.7 Where a puppy is awarded Best in Group/Best in Show placing in accordance with 5.3.6 a or d, the highest placed puppy shall be awarded Best Puppy in Group/Best Puppy in show and there shall be no elimination. This type of judging does not necessarily produce the second, third and fourth best dogs in Group or Show, but rather the four best dogs in the ring from the Best of Breed winners and, in the case of Best In Show, from the Group winners.

Part VIII - Exhibitions Dogs SA Regulations

BEST OF BREED

The judging of "Best of Breed" and "Runner- Up Best of Breed" will be conducted at the completion of judging each breed daily, in the normal way.

Best Exhibit in Group

Only exhibits, which have won Best of Breed, shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit in Group awards 1st, 2nd.

Best Baby Puppy in Group

Only Best Baby Puppy in Group award will be offered. Therefore, only Best Baby Puppy of the Day winners are eligible to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Group.

Best Neuter in Group

Only exhibits, which have won Best Neuter of Breed, shall be eligible to compete for Best Neuter in Group awards.

Best Puppy In Group

Only Best Puppy in Group award will be offered. Therefore, only puppies that have won Best Puppy of Breed are eligible to compete for Best Puppy In Group.

Best Exhibit In Show

Only exhibits, which have won Best Exhibit in Group, shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit in Show awards 1st, 2nd

Best Baby Puppy In Show

Only Best Baby Puppy in Show award will be offered. Therefore, only Best Baby Puppy in Group winners are eligible to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Best Puppy In Show

Only Best Puppy in Show award will be offered. Therefore, only Best Puppy in Group winners are eligible to compete for Best Puppy In Show.

Best Neuter in Show

Only exhibits, which have won Best Neuter in Group, shall be eligible to compete for Best Neuter in Show.

BREED CLUB/GROUP LUNCHES – GUIDELINES

Requests for lunches must be received in writing to the Dog section. No trestles are to be outside bench rails when the Pavilion is open to the public and it is the Breed Club/Group's responsibility to collect and return trestles after usage.

ASSEMBLY RING

No Children under the age of 7 years will be permitted in the Assembly Area.

FANS

No portable fans are permitted in the judging ring.

JUDGING PROGRAMME

The Society reserves the right to alter the Judging programme.

Judging commences at not before 3.00 pm on Saturday6 September 2025

All exhibits must pass through the Check Point and all Music must be presented by 2.45 pm. Bitches without proof of desexing must pass through the Check Point and Vetting by 2.45 pm.

All exhibitors may leave the Showground at the conclusion of the Competition.

Freestyle before HTM, Advanced, Intermediate, Novice, Starter

Presentation of Awards for the Dances with Dogs competition will be held at the conclusion of the event.

ROYAL ADELAIDE SHOW - EXHIBITORS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

HAZARD REPORTING

Exhibitors must notify the Area/Pavilion Supervisor or the Venue Control Centre immediately of any hazards detected. Hazards are any situation which has the potential to cause:

- 1. Injury, illness or death to people or animals either immediately or in the future
- 2. Damage or destruction to property

INCIDENT REPORTING

Exhibitors must notify the Area/Pavilion Supervisor or the Venue Management Office immediately an incident occurs which has resulted in:

- 1. The injury, illness or death of any person or animal
- 2. The damage, destruction or loss of property
- 3. A near miss incident that could have resulted in the consequences listed in 1 and 2

WASTE DISPOSAL

All waste including liquids must be disposed of responsibly and placed in the appropriate bin or receptacle. Storm drains must not be used for the disposal of any waste.

HAZARD MINIMISATION

All areas must be kept in a clean and tidy order with clearly defined and available access and exit routes at all times. Build-up of combustible waste must be avoided.

Care must be taken to minimise trip hazards and obstacles that people may walk into.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

The RA&HS are to be advised of all hazardous materials that are brought onto the Showground. Appropriate warning signs and Safety Data Sheets (SDS) will need to be provided before allowing these materials on site. SDS are to be available onsite and provided immediately upon request by an RA&HS Representative.

MEDIA COMMENTS

Any public comment on emergencies, incidents or other venue matters should only come from the RA&HS. The key media spokesperson for the RA&HS is the Marketing Manager.

DUTY OF CARE

It is important to ensure your own safety and that of all other site personnel, visitors and general public at the Adelaide Showground.

All exhibitors have a "Duty of Care" to avoid exposing themselves or other people to situations which could lead to injury. This "Duty of Care" extends to the prevention of damage to property.

LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

1. Release

Entry to and remaining on the Showground is entirely at the risk of the Exhibitor and to the maximum extent permitted by law, the Exhibitor releases the Society (which term includes in this clause the Society's officers, employees, members and agents), from all claims and demands of every kind resulting from any accident, damage or injury occurring at the Showground, and without limitation, the Exhibitor acknowledges:

- **a)** the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury to or caused by any Exhibit;
- **b**) the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury to or caused by any Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees and Agents;
- **c)** the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury to a Motor Vehicle or any of its contents whilst it is located on the Showground; and
- **d)** without limiting Regulations 1 (a), 1 (b) and (c) above, the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury resulting from the sale, treatment, failure to treat, destruction, disposal or other dealing with any Exhibit, or for loss, damage or injury to any personal belongings, equipment or property brought onto the Showground.

2. Indemnity

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Exhibitor must indemnify and keep indemnified the Society and its officers,

employees, members and agents from and against all actions, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, expenses and liabilities including without limitation, consequential loss and loss of profits for which the Society is or may be or become liable in respect of or arising from:

- a) loss, damage or injury to any person in connection with the Exhibit or the relevant Event;
- b) without limiting Regulation 2(a), loss, damage or injury to any other Exhibit or Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees, Agents, or to the property of the Society, or its members, or to the general public, caused or contributed to or by any act or omission of an Exhibit of the Exhibitor or by the Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees or Agents; and
- c) without limiting Regulation 2(a), loss, damage or injury to the Exhibit, or the Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees, or Agents caused or contributed by an act or omission of an Exhibit of the Exhibitor or by the transportation, feeding or housing of an Exhibit of the Exhibitor.

3. Removal from Showground

Without prejudice to any other provision in these Regulations, where the Society, its officers, employees, members or agents removes an Exhibit, or causes an Exhibit to be removed from the Showground, the Exhibit is removed or caused to be removed entirely at the risk of the Exhibitor. The person or persons removing the Exhibit will be deemed to be the agent of the Exhibitor, and his or her acts and omissions will be deemed to be the acts and omissions of the Exhibitor.

4 Insurance

The Society will arrange Animal Exhibitors Public Liability insurance cover for all Exhibitors of Exhibits being animals. The Exhibitor is bound by the terms and conditions of this insurance and by Statutory Duties as defined under the Insurance Contracts Act (1984). Details of the Animal Exhibitors Public Liability insurance are set out in the Relevant Schedule. The Society does not insure first party loss, damage or injury to Exhibits, and Exhibitors should consider purchasing insurance if required.

5. Personal effects

The Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss or damage caused to personal belongings, equipment or property which is brought onto the Showground by an Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees or Agents.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Emergency information and Emergency Assembly Points for the various animal pavilions and stables will be included with Exhibitor List of Entries and Notice to Exhibitor notifications. Competitors should be familiar with these plans.

FIRST AID

During the Royal Adelaide Show, St John provides First Aid Services but it is suggested that competitors have a basic First Aid kit for minor medical requirements.

St John is not in attendance after public hours.

For emergency contact details, check Notice Boards for onsite assistance or dial 000 for a medical emergency.

RA&HS EMERGENCY FACILITIES

Firefighting and other emergency equipment must not be removed or used for any other purpose. Missing or unserviceable equipment should be reported to the Venue Control Centre immediately.

SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in designated locations. The Royal Adelaide Show is a smoke free event.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

The RA&HS Traffic Control Policy imposes speed restrictions within the Showground. For the duration of the Royal Adelaide Show the speed limit is 10 kph on the grounds and 8 kph inside buildings.

The use of vehicles inside the Showground is closely managed during the Royal Adelaide Show. Conditions of entry will be provided with the issue of Vehicle Entry Permits.
