#### **MERINO JUDGING**

Classes 2 & 4 as specified in conditions of class.

All Merino classes except commercial class for non-registered flocks will be judged to the following scale of point's classification for Micron

- 1. Superfine wools from 17.5 Micron and finer
- 2. Fine wools from 17.6 Micron to 19.4 Micron
- 3. Medium Wools from 19.5 Micron to 21.5 Micron
- 4. Strongwools from 21.6 Micron and stronger

For Merino entries the state and adjacent areas are divided into five geographic zones.

Please ensure entries are entered according to the District Council Area in which they are grown.

#### Spinning Fineness (S.F.)

Fleeces will score ½ a point for each tenth of a Micron the S.F. is lower than the mean fibre diameter (M.F.D). To help reduce the percentage differences between the M.F.D. and S.F. for the Micron grades, the following adjustments to the point scores will be applied.




