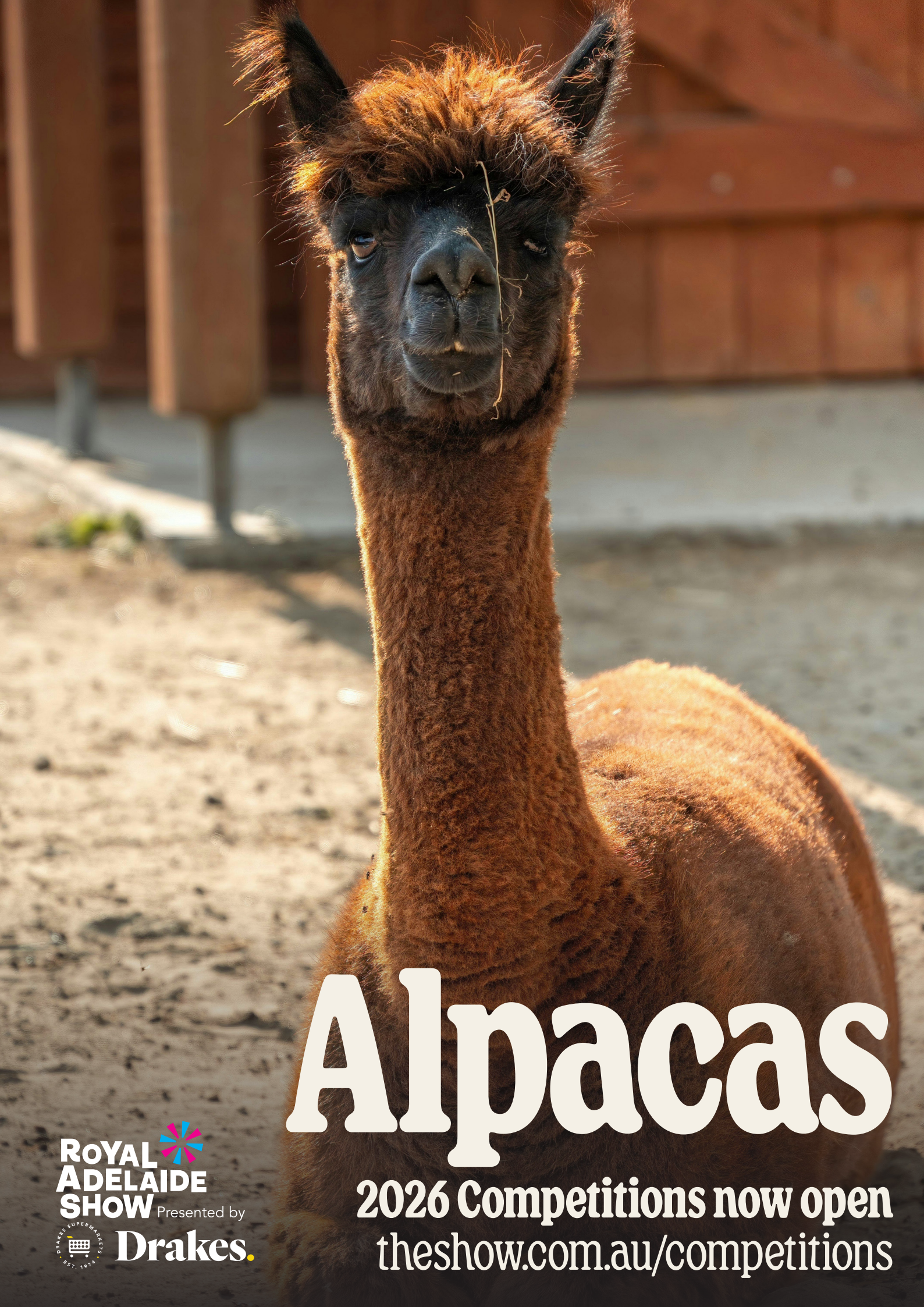

ENTRY INFORMATION

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete the online form at www.theshow.com.au
- Deadline: Friday 17 July 2026 at 5:00 PM CST
- Details of all animals (including Sire's Progeny classes) entered must be submitted at the time of entry.
- All animals must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or held by the exhibitor under a written and recorded lease at the time of entry.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure alpacas and fleeces are entered in the correct colour class according to the [Australian Alpaca Association colour chart](#).
- All alpacas entered must be registered with the Australian Alpaca Association (excluding wethers, Young Parader and Young Judging classes)
- Only one fleece that has been shorn in the 18 months prior to the Show may be shown from any one animal.
- All alpacas must be entered and shown in the name of the registered owner or leasee.

- All exhibitors must be current financial members of RA&HS to receive the discounted entry fee

WITHDRAWALS

- All withdrawals must include exhibitor name, exhibit name, class number and exhibit number (if known).
- Withdrawals can be sent via email to entries@adelaideshowground.com.au and clearly marked "Withdrawal - Alpaca Section".
- Verbal withdrawals will not be accepted.
- Exhibitors who fail to notify the Society of withdrawals at least 24 hours prior to the official arrival time will be fined \$100 for each animal not exhibited.

REFUNDS

- No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries.

PARKING & LOGISTICS**LEADER STREET CARPARK**

- Must be booked when completing your entries.
- Limited availability.

STOCK TRUCK PARKING – MAGIC MILLIONS

- Parking will be available for all trucks, floats, and trailers at Magic Millions.
- Access to this area will be via the corner of Park and Wattle Terraces, Plympton Park.
- **No trucks will be permitted to park on the Showground.**

STOCK MOVEMENTS

- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to adhere to Australian Welfare Standards and Guidelines regarding safe transport of livestock.

UNLOADING/LOADING

- All vehicles are to enter through the Leader Street Gate.
- All alpacas must be unloaded and loaded in the designated areas.
- Alpacas are not permitted onsite prior to the designated times without approval from the RA&HS.
- Alpaca Supervisor will issue departure applications prior to departure.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to remove their alpacas from the pavilion until their allotted departure time. (Fines may be issued)

FLEECE DELIVERY

Fleeces can be delivered by Wednesday 26 August 2026 to either;

- Adelaide Showground, Administration Office, 68 Goodwood Road, Wayville
- via post PO Box 108, Goodwood SA 5034.
- Alternatively, you can arrange delivery to one of the Supervisors

- Fleeces must be in plastic bags or plastic bags inside cloth bags (preferred), with identification of exhibit and class number.
- Fleeces not bagged correctly may be disqualified from competition.
- Fleeces, will be displayed in the Alpaca and Goat Pavilion for the duration of the Royal Adelaide Show.
- Fleeces are to be collected after 2.00 pm on Sunday 13 September.

ANIMAL HEALTH

SICK OR INJURED ANIMALS

- Any alpaca considered either diseased or dangerous, or not of acceptable Show standard, the Society reserves the right of refusing its admittance to or removing the same from the Showground at the exhibitor's expense.
- If a qualified vet appointed by the Society determines that an animal is seriously sick, injured, or unfit to remain at the Showground, the Society may:
 - Require the exhibitor to remove the animal immediately, or
 - Arrange for the animal to be removed or humanely destroyed if necessary.
- If the exhibitor does not act within the time given, the Society will remove the animal and charge the exhibitor for all related costs.
- The exhibitor is fully responsible for the animal at all times, including any person handling or removing it on their behalf.
- The exhibitor must cover any costs, damages, or claims resulting from the animal's condition, transport, or care.
- The pavilion supervisor must be notified immediately if a vet treats any sick or diseased animal.
- All veterinary costs during the Show are the exhibitor's responsibility.

REQUIREMENTS

- Lice:
 - Exhibitors must ensure animals are checked for lice prior to arrival.
 - Animals will be inspected for *Bovicola breviceps* (alpaca biting or chewing lice) prior to entering the Alpaca and Goat Pavilion.
 - Any animals found to have signs of lice will be removed from the Showground immediately.
- Johnes Disease: must not be from properties known to be infected with Johnes Disease.

- No hormone growth promotants permitted
- Animals must not have been exposed to any communicable/notifiable disease/s within 14 days prior to the show.
- All male animals must be completely entire and deemed physically sound.
- Any marks of spaying on females shall disqualify them from competing.
- All wethers must be physically sound and must have been castrated.

DOCUMENTATION

- NLIS or IAR eartag required.
- National South American Camelid Declaration form required at unloading

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION & OWNERSHIP

- Alpacas must be owned or leased (with written proof) by the exhibitor at the time of entry.

COMPANION ALPACAS & CRIA

- No companion alpacas or bottle fed cria are permitted.
- Cria at foot may be brought onto the Showground only with permission of the Supervisor.

INSPECTION OF ALPACAS

- All alpacas will be inspected for;
 - general well-being
 - eligibility
 - correctness
- This will take place in the Pavilion and an attendant must be present to supply any information required by the inspectors.
- Inspections shall be conducted according to the Stewards Inspection Checklist as shown in the AAA Showing Rules Manual.
- Any animal rejected as a result of this inspection must be removed from the Showground, the time of removal to be at the discretion of the Committee.

CLASS TRANSFERS

- The Chief Steward will classify all entries for colour.
- Entries may be transferred to the class in which, in his/her opinion, it should have been entered.
- Classes may be combined or split as they see fit in consultation with the Supervisor.

PEN DISPLAY

- Each stud is permitted to display one sign for every four pens occupied by alpacas:
 - One sign allowed: max 1200mm × 600mm
 - Logo, name and address of exhibitor only to be shown.
 - Exhibitors are permitted to decorate their pens with curtain delineators.
 - Ribbons and sashes on display must relate to the animals in that pen.

IMPORTANT DATES

- 5 September, 2026 is the reference date for the calculation of age of an animal entering age classes at the Royal Adelaide Show.
 - 6 months to under 12 months - 6/9/25 to 5/3/26

- 12 months to under 18 months - 6/3/25 to 5/9/25
- 18 months to under 30 months - 6/3/24 to 5/3/25
- 30 months to under 48 months - 6/9/23 to 5/3/24
- 30 months and over - On or before 5/3/23
- 48 months and over - born on or before 5/9/22
- Halter class entry must have a minimum fleece length of 50 millimetres for Huacaya and Suri, and a maximum fleece age:
 - for Huacaya of under 14 months.
 - for Suri in a first fleece of under 18 months, and
 - for Suri in a second or subsequent fleece of under 14 months.

ENTRY PASSES

- 1 - 4 head x 1 ticket per day
- 5 - 8 head x 2 tickets per day
- 9 or more x 3 tickets per day

If additional passes are required, please consider purchasing an RA&HS Membership.

GRAND PARADE & JUDGING RING

- The Alpaca and Goat Pavilion will be open from 9.00 am to 7.00 pm
- Handlers and all stewards appearing in the judging ring must wear
 - Black shirt, with or without black vest, over black pants and covered shoes.
 - Juniors must have long trousers (moleskins or school trousers accepted) with covered shoes.
 - NO blue denim jeans, shorts or sneakers permitted.
 - Stewards assisting inside the pavilion must be smartly dressed.
 - White dustcoats should be worn by handlers in the Grand Parade.
 - Alpacas must not leave the judging ring until directed by the Judge or Ring Steward.

PROTESTS

- An exhibitor may lodge a protest against another exhibitor or a Show Official.
- The sole grounds of a protest shall be a breach of the Show rules.
- Subject to the General Regulations, protests shall be addressed to the Chief Executive and be lodged at his office on the Showground before 6.00 pm on the day the decision in question has been made.
- Fee: \$50 which may be forfeited to the Society if in the sole opinion of the Chief Steward the protest is unfounded, frivolous or vexatious.
- The protest and all matters arising therefrom shall be determined conclusively as to all matters by the Society and shall not be the subject of any appeal to any court.

DUTY OF CARE

- ***Exhibitors must ensure their own safety and that of all other site personnel, visitors and general public at the Adelaide Showground.***
- All competitors have a "Duty of Care" to avoid exposing themselves or other people to situation which could lead to injury.
- This "Duty of Care" extends to the prevention of damage to property.

ALPACAS ON DISPLAY – SECOND HALF OF THE SHOW

Aim

- Have approximately 30 alpacas remain for display during the second half of the Show.

Criteria

- All standard rules, regulations and ownership requirements apply.
 - Proof of ownership and animal ID must be provided to the Alpaca Supervisor.
 - Registered and unregistered alpacas are accepted.
- Usual health standards apply.
- Normal shed rules apply (cleaning, exercising, signage, etc.).
- No alpacas under 6 months old, except naturally feeding cria at foot with their dam.
 - Bottle-fed cria are not permitted.
- Priority for display space goes to exhibitors, stewards and official volunteers from the first half of the Show.
 - Additional spaces may be offered to other breeders/owners if available.
- Owners may request to swap alpacas via the Alpaca Supervisor.
 - Additional Health & Movement documents required.

Advertising & Signage

- The Alpaca Pavilion is for competition and display, not commercial activity.
- Display cards must match first-half requirements:
 - Maximum size 1200mm x 600mm, including logo, name and contact details.
- No “For Sale” signs or sales handouts allowed.
- No handouts promoting specific enterprises or individual animals.
- Educational materials (fact sheets, posters, general industry info) are permitted.
- Business cards are allowed, but **no selling, persuading, or coercion** in the Pavilion.
- A designated industry display area will be provided; no individual promotion outside this area.

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

CLEANING & WASTE

- Keep your area clean throughout the Show.
- Bring your own brooms, shovels and buckets.
- Use manure bins only for manure — not general rubbish.
- Wastewater must not be emptied in the wash-down sinks.
- Dispose of all waste and feed properly before leaving.
- Fines may apply for non-compliance.

BEDDING & PENS

- Only straw is allowed.
- Extra straw available from the Fodder Store.
- Only feed bags may be hung from pens.
- Rugs and bags must not be fixed to sides or tops of pens while the hall is open to the public.

FODDER STORE

- Located at the western end of the Tin Dairy.
- All sales are credit card only.
- Bring your own feed or purchase from the store.
- Excess fodder may be removed at the Committee’s discretion.
- Exhibitors must not sell or promote fodder on the Showground.

CONDUCT & SAFETY

SMOKING & ALCOHOL

- Smoking/vaping only in designated areas.
- Alcohol is only allowed in designated areas.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

- All electrical items must be tag tested.
- Double adaptors are strictly prohibited.

PRIZES & AWARDS

- We aim to ensure all listed prizes are accurate at the time of publishing.
- If a sponsor withdraws a prize, it will revert to the default amount.

Standard Class Prizes (unless otherwise specified)

- First, \$25 and ribbon
- Second, \$18 and ribbon
- Third, \$8 and ribbon

RA&HS sashes will be awarded to all

- Champions, Reserve Champions and Special Awards

Champion Selection

- Champions are chosen from 1st prize winners.
- Reserve Champions are selected from remaining 1st prize winners in the same class.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

- Prize money will be paid via EFT by the end of October.
- Unclaimed prizes by 11 December will be forfeited.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

- Prize money listed in the schedule does not include GST.
- If you're GST registered and provide your ABN:
 - RA&HS will add GST to your prize money.
 - A Recipient Created Tax Invoice will be issued.
- By confirming GST registration, you agree:
 - Not to issue your own tax invoice for prize money
 - To notify RA&HS if your GST status changes
- If you are not registered for GST (or are entering as a hobbyist)
 - Prize money will be paid without GST.
- Incorrect GST details may result in tax being withheld at the highest rate.

SPECIAL AWARDS

MOST SUCCESSFUL NEW EXHIBITOR IN ALPACA BREED & FLEECE CLASSES

Open to any exhibitor showing for the first time. Any exhibitor showing at the Royal Adelaide Show in 2026 is eligible for this Trophy. Points will be awarded based upon the success of entries in ALL Alpaca Sections - Huacaya, Suri, Production and Fleeces.

MOST SUCCESSFUL ALPACA EXHIBITOR IN BREED & FLEECE CLASSES

Any exhibitor showing at the Royal Adelaide Show in 2026 is eligible for this award. Points will be awarded based upon the success of entries in ALL Alpaca Sections - Huacaya, Suri, Production and Fleeces.

A sliding scale of points, reflecting the level of any award, will be used:-

First -	5 points
Second -	3 points
Third -	1 points

The exhibitor with the highest points score shall be the winner.

Should a tie occur, the number of entries by the tied exhibitors may be considered to determine the winner.

THE URRBRAE PRIZE BEST OVERALL SCHOOL

This award is open to student exhibitors who enter in class Wethers and the Junior Handlers and Young Judges classes at the Royal Adelaide Show in 2026. Points will be awarded based upon the point system on placing of these classes/sections.

A sliding scale of points, reflecting the level of any award, will be used:-

First	10 points
Second	8 points
Third	6 points
Fourth	4 points
