ENTRY INFORMATION

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete the online form at www.theshow.com.au
- Deadline: Monday 20 July 2026 at 5:00 PM CST
- Entries must be registered, no “pending” registrations will be accepted.
- The main emphasis of entries is the number of spaces required.
- The Committee reserves the right to impose a fine of \$150 per space not occupied by an exhibit.
- Details of all animals entered must be submitted at the time of entry.
- Exhibitors shall not bring onto the Adelaide Showground any more animals than spaces booked.
- All entries are subject to approval by individual breed societies that all exhibit details are correct.
- Classes may be split or merged at the discretion of the Beef Cattle Committee
- Animals must be entered in general classes to qualify for group classes
- Cattle will be catalogued in age order.
- Only cattle which are entered for competition will be permitted to enter the Showground.

- All exhibitors must be current financial members of RA&HS
- **Annual Fees:** Adults \$204 Juniors (under 18) \$74

WITHDRAWALS

- All withdrawals must include exhibitor name, exhibit name, class number and exhibit number (if known).
- Withdrawals can be sent via email to entries@adelaideshowground.com.au and clearly marked "Withdrawal - Beef Cattle Section".
- Verbal withdrawals will not be accepted.

REFUNDS

- No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries.

TRANSFERS

- Please ensure cattle are entered in the correct class at the time of entry.
- No exhibit will be transferred to another class after the closing date of entries.

PARKING & LOGISTICS**LEADER STREET CARPARK**

- Must be booked when completing your entries.
- Limited availability.

STOCK TRUCK PARKING – MAGIC MILLIONS

- Parking will be available for all trucks, floats, and trailers at Magic Millions.
- Access to this area will be via the corner of Park and Wattle Terraces.
- **No trucks will be permitted to park on the Showground.**

STOCK MOVEMENTS

- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to adhere to Australian Welfare Standards and Guidelines regarding safe transport of livestock.
- The Society will notify the NLIS database of all movements onto the Showground on behalf of exhibitors.

UNLOADING/LOADING

- All cattle must be unloaded and loaded in the designated areas.
- Cattle are not permitted onsite prior to the designated times without approval from the RA&HS.

AGES OF CATTLE

The table below shows the dates on or between which animals must be born to compete in the respective age classes.

8 MONTHS AND UNDER 14 MONTHS - (1/7/2025 – 31/12/2025)

14 MONTHS AND UNDER 16 MONTHS - (1/5/2025 – 30/6/2025)

16 MONTHS AND UNDER 18 MONTHS - (1/3/2025 – 30/4/2025)

18 MONTHS AND UNDER 24 MONTHS - (1/9/2024 - 1/3/2025)

24 MONTHS AND UNDER 30 MONTHS - (1/3/2024 – 31/8/2024)

24 MONTHS AND OVER - (before 31/8/2024)

30 MONTHS AND OVER - (before 1/3/2024)

All cows 30 months and over must either have a calf at foot or the exhibitor must produce a Veterinary Certificate stating that the cow is in calf. This certificate must be produced to the breed inspectors at inspection time.

ANIMAL HEALTH

SICK OR INJURED ANIMALS

- Any cattle considered either diseased or dangerous, or not of acceptable Show standard, the Society reserves the right of refusing its admittance to or removing the same from the Showground at the exhibitor's expense.
- If a qualified vet appointed by the Society determines that an animal is seriously sick, injured, or unfit to remain at the Showground, the Society may:
 - Require the exhibitor to remove the animal immediately, or
 - Arrange for the animal to be removed or humanely destroyed if necessary.
- If the exhibitor does not act within the time given, the Society will remove the animal and charge the exhibitor for all related costs.
- The exhibitor is fully responsible for the animal at all times, including any person handling or removing it on their behalf.
- The exhibitor must cover any costs, damages, or claims resulting from the animal's condition, transport, or care.
- The pavilion supervisor must be notified immediately if a vet treats any sick or diseased animal.
- All veterinary costs during the Show are the exhibitor's responsibility.

REQUIREMENTS

- Johne's Disease: Minimum Beef Assurance Score J-BAS 6
- Pestivirus: All cattle must be certified non-PI
- Ringworm:
 - Vet certificate required if treated
 - Additional washing, no more than 4 days apart
- No hormone growth promotants permitted
- Animals must not have been exposed to any communicable/notifiable disease/s within 14 days prior to the show.

DOCUMENTATION

- NLIS eartag required (including calves at foot).
- National Cattle Health Statement required at unloading

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION & OWNERSHIP

- All cattle must be purebred and registered in the appropriate Stud Book.
- Cattle must be owned or leased (with written proof) by the exhibitor at the time of entry.

INSPECTION OF CATTLE

- Exhibitors must make Registration Certificates available to Breed inspectors if requested.
- All cattle will be inspected for;
 - identification tattoo and/or NLIS tag no.
 - breed type
 - conformation
- Animals in all classes under 24 months will be mouthed.
- Animals in classes under 24 months must not show more than four permanent teeth.
- A tooth which has erupted from the gum in whole or part shall be deemed to be a permanent tooth.
- An animal entered in any class for an age of under 18 months shall be ineligible for competition in any such class if at the time of inspection of exhibits it has or shows evidence of having had a permanent tooth.
- Any exhibit not complying with the above regulations may need to be removed from the Showground within 12 hours of notification being given to the exhibitor.

CATTLE

- Cattle must not be rugged while the Show is open to the public.
- Feeding of animals is not permitted outside the Cattle Pavilions at any time.
- Animals must not be tethered in unauthorised areas.
- Bulls must be nose rung; females must use nose clips
- Cattle must be secured with halter and neck rope

COWS IN CALF/CALVES AT FOOT

- Cows expected to calve or with a calf born within two weeks prior to the first day of the Show will not be permitted to compete.
- Any cow that calves during the Show must be removed and will be ineligible to compete.
- If a cow has a calf at foot, the calf's date of birth must be listed on the entry form.
- Calves must:
 - Be born on or after 1 January 2026 (i.e. no older than 8 months on 1 September 2026)
 - Be tattooed and the natural offspring of the cow entered
 - Be purebred and eligible for registration with the relevant breed society
 - Remain tethered at all times

NECK & CARDS

- All animals must wear a neck card with their catalogue number during judging.
- Lead animals in group/pair classes must also display the group/pair number.
- Bulls must display their weight on the neck card.
- Only official exhibit cards and approved breed society signs may be displayed:
 - Breed signs: max 500mm wide × 297mm deep
 - One stud sign allowed: max 1200mm × 600mm

GRAND PARADE & JUDGING RING

- All exhibitors are required to parade 50% of their team.
- Handlers under the age of 10 years must be accompanied by a competent person including sign holders.
- Cattle must be handled and/or controlled by a competent handler of at least 8 years of age in the judging ring.
- Approved Breed Uniforms or white dust coats must be worn.

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT**CLEANING & WASTE**

- Keep your area clean throughout the Show.
- Bring your own wheelbarrow and buckets.
- Use manure bins only for manure — not general rubbish.
- Dispose of all waste and feed properly before leaving.
- Fines may apply for non-compliance.

BEDDING

- Only sawdust is allowed (no straw).
- 3 bags of sawdust provided per 3 spaces booked.
- Extra sawdust available from the Fodder Store.
- Bedding boards are allowed (bring your own).

CLIPPING CHUTES

- Clipping chutes will be permitted (in a designated area) with prior approval.

FEED LOFT ACCESS

- Feed and gear can be stored in the lofts (not exceeding maximum weight).
- Do not walk on the lofts under any circumstances.

EXERCISE AREA

- Cattle must only be exercised on the Beef Cattle Lawn

WASHING OF STOCK

- Use only designated wash bays.
- Bring your own hose with standard fittings.
- No powered equipment allowed in wash bays.

LOCKERS

- Lockers must be booked when submitting your entry.
- Availability is limited and not guaranteed.
- Exhibitors with 1–5 spaces are eligible for 1 locker.
- Exhibitors with more than 5 spaces may apply for up to 2 lockers.
- Exhibitors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult to stay overnight.
- Cooking or heating devices are not allowed in lockers.
- Unauthorized use of lockers will result in a \$100 fine and loss of locker privileges for the next Show.
- Lockers cannot be moved or changed without approval from RA&HS.
- Storage of gear between the Heifer Expo and the Show is not allowed.

FODDER STORE

- Located at the western end of the Tin Dairy.
- All sales are credit card only.
- Bring your own feed or purchase from the store.
- Excess fodder may be removed at the Committee's discretion.
- Exhibitors must not sell or promote fodder on the Showground.

CONDUCT & SAFETY

SMOKING & ALCOHOL

- Smoking/vaping only in designated areas.
- Alcohol is only allowed in designated areas.
- No alcohol or food preparation in Cattle Pavilions or lockers.
- Use the provided kitchen facilities for food and drinks.

DOGS

- Dogs are not permitted in the Beef Cattle area.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

- Only hairdryers and clippers are permitted.
- All electrical items must be tag tested.
- Double adaptors are strictly prohibited.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Exhibitors must behave professionally, courteously and respectfully toward officials, judges, other exhibitors and the public.
- Instructions from Show Officials must be followed promptly and safely.
- Exhibitors must not interfere with another person's work or behave in an intimidating, aggressive or inappropriate manner.
- Exhibitors must be clean, well-presented and wear any required identification.
- Exhibitors must follow all competition rules and regulations for their class.
- Any mistreatment of animals or inappropriate behaviour may result in removal from competition.
- Exhibitors must avoid posting defamatory, disrespectful, misleading or inflammatory content related to the Show, animals, officials or other exhibitors.
- Information should be honest, accurate and respectful of the Society and its values.

PRIZES & AWARDS

- We aim to ensure all listed prizes are accurate at the time of publishing.
- If a sponsor withdraws a prize, it will revert to the default amount.

Champion Selection

- Champions are chosen from 1st prize winners.
- Reserve Champions are selected from remaining 1st prize winners in the same class.

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR - INDIVIDUAL BREEDS

- Points to be allotted as follows:
 - First, 5 points
 - Second, 3 points
 - Third, 1 point
- In the event of a tie,
 - Champion earns +2 points
 - Reserve Champion earns +1 point
- Points from special classes (except Breeders' Group) do not count.
- Points are awarded regardless of the number of entries in each class.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

- Prize money will be paid via EFT by the end of October.
- Unclaimed prizes by 11 December will be forfeited.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

- Prize money listed in the schedule does not include GST.
- If you're GST registered and provide your ABN:
 - RA&HS will add GST to your prize money.
 - A Recipient Created Tax Invoice will be issued.
