ENTRY INFORMATION

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete the online form at www.theshow.com.au
- Deadline: Friday 3 July 2026 at midnight
- The competition is open to all Tertiary bodies and Schools in Australia and Breeders.
- All goats must be wethers.
- All goats entered by schools must be cared for by members of the School for at least twelve weeks prior to the Show.
- Details of all animals entered must be submitted at the time of entry.
- A maximum of ten goats between the two school classes, 201 and 301, but are permitted to nominate up to two reserve animals to allow for late injuries, sickness etc.
- Reserve entries do not incur an entry fee but must be registered before the closing date.
- Only goats which are entered for competition will be permitted to enter the Showground.
- The Society reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in Led Goat Wether Classes.

WITHDRAWALS

- All withdrawals must include exhibitor name, exhibit name, class number and exhibit number (if known).
- Withdrawals can be sent via email to entries@adelaideshowground.com.au and clearly marked "Withdrawal - Goat Section".
- Verbal withdrawals will not be accepted.

REFUNDS

- No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries.

TRANSFERS

- Please ensure exhibits are entered in the correct class at time of entry.
- No exhibit will be transferred to another class after the closing date of entries.

PREFERRED WEIGHT RANGE

Exhibits will be weighed and classified into the following classes for hoof judging.

- Lightweight: 20 kg to 39.9 kg
- Heavy Weight: 40 kg and over

PARKING & LOGISTICS

LEADER STREET CARPARK

- Must be booked when completing your entries.
- Limited availability.

STOCK TRUCK PARKING – MAGIC MILLIONS

- Parking will be available for all trucks, floats, and trailers at Magic Millions.
- Access to this area will be via the corner of Park and Wattle Terraces.
- **No trucks will be permitted to park on the Showground.**

STOCK MOVEMENTS

- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to adhere to Australian Welfare Standards and Guidelines regarding safe transport of livestock.
- The Society will notify the NLIS database of all movements onto the Showground on behalf of exhibitors.

UNLOADING/LOADING

- All goats must be unloaded and loaded in the designated areas.
- Goats are not permitted onsite prior to the designated times without approval from the RA&HS.
- All departure applications are to be submitted to the RA&HS Diverse Farming Councillor 24 hours prior to departure.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to remove their goats from the pavilion until their allotted departure time. (Fines may be issued)

ANIMAL HEALTH

SICK OR INJURED ANIMALS

- Any goat considered either diseased or dangerous, or not of acceptable Show standard, the Society reserves the right of refusing its admittance to or removing the same from the Showground at the exhibitor's expense.
- If a qualified vet appointed by the Society determines that an animal is seriously sick, injured, or unfit to remain at the Showground, the Society may:
 - Require the exhibitor to remove the animal immediately, or
 - Arrange for the animal to be removed or humanely destroyed if necessary.
- If the exhibitor does not act within the time given, the Society will remove the animal and charge the exhibitor for all related costs.

- The exhibitor is fully responsible for the animal at all times, including any person handling or removing it on their behalf.
- The exhibitor must cover any costs, damages, or claims resulting from the animal's condition, transport, or care.
- The pavilion supervisor must be notified immediately if a vet treats any sick or diseased animal.
- All veterinary costs during the Show are the exhibitor's responsibility.

REQUIREMENTS

- Lice:
 - Exhibitors must ensure animals are checked for lice prior to arrival.
 - Any animals found to have lice will be removed from the Showground immediately.
- Johne's Disease: Minimum Assurance Score 5
- No hormone growth promotants permitted
- Animals must not have been exposed to any communicable/notifiable disease/s within 14 days prior to the show.

DOCUMENTATION

- NLIS eartag required.
- National Goat Health Statement required at unloading

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION & OWNERSHIP

- Led Wether goats do not need to be registered with a breed association.

INSPECTION OF GOATS

- All goats will be inspected for;
 - NLIS tag no/eID tag.
 - Lice
- This will take place in the Pavilion and an attendant must be present to supply any information required by the inspectors.
- Any animal rejected as a result of this inspection must be removed from the Showground, the time of removal to be at the discretion of the Committee.

NECK CARDS & SIGNAGE

- All handlers must wear a neck card with their catalogue number during judging.
- Each exhibitor is permitted to display one sign for every four pens occupied by goats:
 - One sign allowed: max 1200mm × 600mm
 - Ribbons and sashes on display must relate to the animals in that pen.

ENTRY PASSES

- Schools - five admit-one tickets per animal entered to a maximum of 40 tickets per day.
- Breeders – two admit one tickets per animal per day.

GRAND PARADE & JUDGING RING

- All schools will be encouraged to lead their wethers in the Parade.
- Handlers under the age of 10 years must be accompanied by a competent person including sign holders.

- Goats must be handled and/or controlled by a competent handler of at least 8 years of age in the judging ring.
- Approved Breed Uniforms or white dust coats must be worn.
- Schools may wear their school uniform in the judging ring.
- The Alpaca and Goat Pavilion will be open from 9.00 am to 7.00 pm.

DUTY OF CARE

- ***Exhibitors must ensure their own safety and that of all other site personnel, visitors and general public at the Adelaide Showground.***
- All competitors have a "Duty of Care" to avoid exposing themselves or other people to any situation which could lead to injury.
- This "Duty of Care" extends to the prevention of damage to property.

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

CLEANING & WASTE

- Keep your area clean throughout the Show.
- Bring your own brooms, shovels and buckets.
- Use manure bins only for manure — not general rubbish.
- Dispose of all waste and feed properly before leaving.
- Fines may apply for non-compliance.

BEDDING & PENS

- Only straw is allowed.
- Extra straw available from the Fodder Store.
- Feed must be stored in suitable bags or containers.
- Any feed brought onto the Showground in poultry or pig feed bags will be removed.

WASHING OF STOCK

- Goats must be washed prior to arrival at the Showground.
- Goats will not be permitted to be washed at the Showground unless approved by a RA&HS Councillor.

FODDER STORE

- Located at the western end of the Tin Dairy.
- All sales are credit card only.
- Bring your own feed or purchase from the store.
- Excess fodder may be removed at the Committee's discretion.
- Exhibitors must not sell or promote fodder on the Showground.

CONDUCT & SAFETY

SMOKING & ALCOHOL

- Smoking/vaping only in designated areas.
- Alcohol is only allowed in designated areas.

DOGS

- Dogs are not permitted in the Alpaca and Goat Pavilion.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

- All electrical items must be tag tested.
- Double adaptors are strictly prohibited.

PRIZES & AWARDS

- We aim to ensure all listed prizes are accurate at the time of publishing.
- If a sponsor withdraws a prize, it will revert to the default amount.

Standard Class Prizes (unless otherwise specified)

- First, \$30 and ribbon
- Second, \$20 and ribbon
- Third, \$10 and ribbon

Additional Ribbons:

- 10 to 15 exhibits - 4th ribbon
- 16 to 20 exhibits - 5th ribbon
- Over 20 exhibits – 6th ribbon

RA&HS sashes will be awarded to all

- Champions, Reserve Champions and Special Awards

Champion Selection

- Champions are chosen from 1st prize winners.
- Reserve Champions are selected from remaining 1st prize winners in the same class section and second place to the champion.
- Grand Champion will be selected from all class champions.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

- Prize money will be paid via EFT by the end of October.
- Unclaimed prizes by 11 December will be forfeited.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

- Prize money listed in the schedule does not include GST.
- If you're GST registered and provide your ABN:
 - RA&HS will add GST to your prize money.
 - A Recipient Created Tax Invoice will be issued.
- By confirming GST registration, you agree:
 - Not to issue your own tax invoice for prize money
 - To notify RA&HS if your GST status changes
- If you are not registered for GST (or are entering as a hobbyist)
 - Prize money will be paid without GST.
- Incorrect GST details may result in tax being withheld at the highest rate.
- RA&HS does not offer tax advice. Please consult your accountant or tax advisor if unsure.
