

2026 PARKING AND CAMPING OPTIONS

Car Parking

Car Parking at the Royal is very restricted and allocations are spread out across all sections. Available car park passes will show for purchase within your entry login - until all allotted spaces are sold out.

If you do not see an option to purchase a car park, that means the allotment is full.

I will start a waitlist for car parking at this point but cannot guarantee any spaces.

You CAN NOT park your vehicle in the horse unloading area and you cannot camp on the Adelaide Showground premises.

For 2026 the Royal Adelaide Show has arranged 2 options for the HIA competitors for self-contained camping and parking of trailers.

Trailer Parking and Camping Options

Option 1

Magic Millions will again be available and can be booked through the entry's portal for The Show. Direct public transport links to the showgrounds are available.

Magic Millions are offering limited facilities (unisex shower/toilet). The site is fully secure, and security will be posted between 6am and 10.30pm for vehicle arrivals. Pedestrian access only will be available between 10:30pm and 6:00am. Video surveillance is setup on the site.

Parking only (strictly no staying in your trailer) is \$30/day - will be checked and anyone found camping in parking only will be charged additional costs. Camping \$60/day / allotment.

Please ensure you advise the size and type of vehicle when making your bookings.

Option 2

The Metro Showjumping Club will make their facility available for competitors this year. Location: 1 Warren Avenue, Glenelg North SA

Camping is fully self-contained, and it must be noted there is no security on site! Camping and parking are strictly at your own risk. The grounds are fully fenced, and access will be via a gate code.

All enquires and bookings for the Metro Showjumping Club are to be made direct. They are not being handed by the RA&HS.

Costs at Metro will be: \$25/day parking only (strictly no camping) and \$35/day for self-contained camping (no power, water or facilities).

Also note: the Metro grounds do not have direct transport links to the showground like Magic Millions has! You will have to find your own way to and from the showgrounds each day (and parking at/around the showground).
