ENTRY INFORMATION

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete the online form at www.theshow.com.au
- Deadline: Friday 31 July 2026 at 5:00 pm CST
- Proof of age, registration and ownership should be available at the time of inspection and judging.
- All animals must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or held by the exhibitor under a written and recorded lease at the time of entry.
- Exhibits may not compete in more than one class, except group classes.
- Only pigs which are entered for competition will be permitted to enter the Showground.
- All exhibits will be catalogued in age order.
- **Entries will not be accepted from a property under quarantine.**

MEMBERSHIP

- All exhibitors must be current financial members of RA&HS to receive the discounted entry fee
- **Annual Fees:** Adults \$204 Juniors (under 18) \$74
- Please go to www.rahs.com.au/membership

WITHDRAWALS

- Every animal entered must be exhibited unless a certificate signed by the exhibitor is lodged with the Society at least 14 days before the opening day of the Show, stating that the animal is unable to compete.
- All withdrawals must include exhibitor name, exhibit name, class number and exhibit number (if known).
- Withdrawals can be sent via email to entries@adelaideshowground.com.au and clearly marked "Withdrawal - Pig Section".
- Verbal withdrawals will not be accepted.
- A fine of \$50 may be imposed for all late withdrawals unless notified by a statutory declaration setting out full reasons for withdrawal, together with an explanatory certificate signed by a veterinary surgeon.
- Notification must be received prior to 9.00 am on Saturday 5 September.
- Non-payment of these fines will debar exhibitors from parading their remaining pigs before the judge.

REFUNDS

- No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries.

TRANSFERS

- Please ensure exhibits are entered in the correct class at time of entry.
- No exhibit will be transferred to another class after the closing date of entries.

PARKING & LOGISTICS

LEADER STREET CARPARK

- Must be booked when completing your entries.
- Limited availability.

STOCK TRUCK PARKING – MAGIC MILLIONS

- Parking will be available for all trucks, floats, and trailers at Magic Millions.
- Access to this area will be via the corner of Park and Wattle Terraces.
- **No trucks will be permitted to park on the Showground.**

STOCK MOVEMENTS

- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to adhere to Australian Welfare Standards and Guidelines regarding safe transport of livestock.
- The Society will notify the NLIS database of all movements onto the Showground on behalf of exhibitors.
- Piglets that have not been weaned and are moving with their mother are exempt from identification.

UNLOADING/LOADING

- All pigs must be unloaded and loaded in the designated areas.
- Pigs are not permitted onsite prior to the designated times without approval from the RA&HS.
- All departure applications are to be submitted to the Pig Supervisor 24 hours prior to departure.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to remove their pigs from the pavilion until their allotted departure time. (Fines may be issued)

DEPARTURE

- No more than 30% of the total number of pigs exhibited can be removed
- Remaining pigs, including sows and litters must remain on the Showground until 10.00 pm on Sunday 13 September (except interstate pigs).
- All departures must be via the eastern doors of the Pig Pavilion.
- Applications for priority must be lodged with the Pig Supervisor by 12noon on Thursday 10 September.

ANIMAL HEALTH

SICK OR INJURED ANIMALS

- Any pigs considered either diseased or dangerous, or not of acceptable Show standard, the Society reserves the right of refusing its admittance to or removing the same from the Showground at the exhibitor's expense.
- If a qualified vet appointed by the Society determines that an animal is seriously sick, injured, or unfit to remain at the Showground, the Society may:
 - Require the exhibitor to remove the animal immediately, or
 - Arrange for the animal to be removed or humanely destroyed if necessary.
- If the exhibitor does not act within the time given, the Society will remove the animal and charge the exhibitor for all related costs.
- The exhibitor is fully responsible for the animal at all times, including any person handling or removing it on their behalf.
- The exhibitor must cover any costs, damages, or claims resulting from the animal's condition, transport, or care.

- The pavilion supervisor must be notified immediately if a vet treats any sick or diseased animal.
- All veterinary costs during the Show are the exhibitor's responsibility.

REQUIREMENTS

- Porcine Brucellosis:
 - Pigs will not be allowed to enter the Showground from herds where Porcine Brucellosis is known or suspected.
 - Non-accredited herds must meet one of the following criteria
 - Have a negative brucellosis serological test result conducted within the previous 30 days.
 - Be moving to a South Australian facility approved by the Chief Inspector of Stock that carries out brucellosis testing before release.

DOCUMENTATION

All exhibitors are encouraged to be accredited through the Australian Pork Industry Quality Assurance Program (APIQ)

- NLIS eartag or brand of property of origin required.
- Breeding pigs entering South Australia from Queensland and New South Wales must have completed a [pig health assessment](#)
- National Vendor Declaration (Pig Pass)

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION & OWNERSHIP

- Pigs must be owned or leased (with written proof) by the exhibitor at the time of entry.
- All pigs over 12 months of age entered in stud classes must be registered with the Australian Pig Breeders Association of Australia in order to confirm the integrity of the breed stock.
- All pigs under 12 months of age must be recorded with the Australian Pig Breeders Association of Australia in order to confirm the integrity of the breed stock.

WEIGHING OF PIGS

- All Commercial Trade/School Competition pigs will be weighed on Tuesday 8 September.
- The Committee reserves the right to weigh the pork and bacon entries.

DISPLAY CARDS

- Each exhibitor is permitted to display one sign for every pig:
 - 1200mm × 600mm max
 - Stud name, exhibit number, animal name and ID Number, date of birth, average daily growth rate, days old, weight & weigh date, P2, mating date if applicable, sire and dam details.
 - Ribbons and sashes on display must relate to the animals in that pen.

AGE RANGE

The table below shows the dates on or between which animals must be born to compete in the respective age classes.

19 MONTHS AND OVER (before 1/2/25)

12 MONTHS AND UNDER 19 MONTHS (1/2/24 to 31/8/25)

9 MONTHS AND UNDER 12 MONTHS (1/8/25 to 31/10/25)

7 MONTHS AND UNDER 9 MONTHS (1/12/25 to 31/1/26)

5 MONTHS AND UNDER 7 MONTHS (1/2/26 to 31/3/26)

UNDER 5 MONTHS (After 31/3/26)

TRIO OF PIGS

- They will be judged on evenness/type and the ability to breed for both commercial and pure bred applications.
- Exhibit numbers for the group must be handed to supervisor by 10.00am Saturday 5 September and will be limited to one entry per pure breed per exhibitor.

ENTRY PASSES

- One Full Show Pass per six entries.

WHITE ATTIRE

- Exhibitors and/or attendants shall wear white attire during judging.

SALES OF PIGS & RESTRICTIONS

- Boars:
 - All boars over 12 months must be detusked.
 - Boars over 12 months are ineligible for the auction
 - Boars Under 12 months are eligible for the auction, however each exhibitor is limited to 3 boars per breed to sell in the auction
 - All boars removed from the Showground must be in separate pens when transporting.
- Sows:
 - Sow entered in 12 months and over classes must have reared a litter or must be visibly in pig.
 - Any sow which is offered for sale as being in pig must be in pig to purebred boar.
- In all classes, the animals name, date of birth, tattoo number, sire, dam, registrations and recordings to be handed to the Supervisor by 10am on Saturday 5 September.
- If a judge considers that a pig is overgrown for its age, he/she has the power to disqualify same.

SELLING AGENTS

- The selling agent for pigs at the 2026 Royal Adelaide Show is Nutrien Ag Mount Pleasant
- All Pigs eligible for the Stud Auction must be prepared for cataloguing & photographing by 9am Friday morning.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to assist the selling agent with cataloguing. NO ASISTANCE, NO SALE.
- Any pigs ineligible for the auction but are eligible for private sale must be sold at that specific breeds average price from the auction.
- All private sale pigs must be sold through the supporting selling agent

SALE ORDER

- Feature Breed followed by catalogue order.

DUTY OF CARE

- ***Exhibitors must ensure their own safety and that of all other site personnel, visitors and general public at the Adelaide Showground.***
- All competitors have a "Duty of Care" to avoid exposing themselves or other people to situation which could lead to injury.
- This "Duty of Care" extends to the prevention of damage to property.

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

CLEANING & WASTE

- Keep your area clean throughout the Show.
- Use manure bins only for manure — not general rubbish.
- Pens must be cleaned by 8.00 am daily.
- Refuse can be deposited in alleyway.
- Dispose of all waste and feed properly before leaving.
- Fines may apply for non-compliance.

BEDDING & PENS

- Only straw is allowed.
- Extra straw available from the Fodder Store.

LOCKERS

- Lockers must be booked when submitting your entry.
- Availability is limited and not guaranteed.
- Exhibitors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult to stay overnight.
- Cooking or heating devices are not allowed in lockers.
- Unauthorized use of lockers will result in a \$100 fine and loss of locker privileges for the next Show.
- Lockers cannot be moved or changed without approval from RA&HS.

FODDER STORE

- Located at the western end of the Tin Dairy.
- All sales are credit card only.
- Bring your own feed or purchase from the store.
- Excess fodder may be removed at the Committee's discretion.
- Exhibitors must not sell or promote fodder on the Showground.

CONDUCT & SAFETY

SMOKING & ALCOHOL

- Smoking/vaping only in designated areas.
- Alcohol is only allowed in designated areas.

DOGS

- Dogs are not permitted in the Pig Pavilion.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

- All electrical items must be tag tested.
- Double adaptors are strictly prohibited.

PRIZES & AWARDS

- We aim to ensure all listed prizes are accurate at the time of publishing.
- If a sponsor withdraws a prize, it will revert to the default amount.

- First, \$20 and ribbon
- Second, \$12 and ribbon
- Third, \$9 and ribbon

Feature Breed Class Prizes (unless otherwise specified)

- First, \$40 and ribbon

- 10 to 15 exhibits - 4th ribbon

Commercial Class Prizes (unless otherwise specified)

- First \$50 and ribbon
- Second \$30 and ribbon

RA&HS sashes will be awarded to all

- Champions, Reserve Champions and Special Awards

Champion Selection

- Champions are chosen from 1st prize winners.
- Reserve Champions can be selected from the remaining 1st prize class winners as well as the exhibit runner up in class to the champion.
- Junior Champion Boars will be selected from exhibits under 9 months old.
- Junior Champion Sows will be selected from exhibits under 9 months old.

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR AWARDS

- Points to be allotted as follows:
 - First, 3 points
 - Second, 2 points
 - Third, 1 point
- In the event of a tie,
 - Senior Champion earns +3 points
 - Junior Champion and Reserve Senior Champions earn +2 points
 - Junior Reserve Champion earns +1 point
 - Fourth, Fifth & Six will be considered
- Points are awarded regardless of the number of entries in each class.
- Points will not count in any class that has less than two or more exhibitors in the breed.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

- Prize money will be paid via EFT by the end of October.
- Unclaimed prizes by 11 December will be forfeited.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

- Prize money listed in the schedule does not include GST.
- If you're GST registered and provide your ABN:
 - RA&HS will add GST to your prize money.
 - A Recipient Created Tax Invoice will be issued.
- By confirming GST registration, you agree:
 - Not to issue your own tax invoice for prize money
 - To notify RA&HS if your GST status changes
- If you are not registered for GST (or are entering as a hobbyist)
 - Prize money will be paid without GST.
- Incorrect GST details may result in tax being withheld at the highest rate.
