### JUDGES 2026

#### Dusan Paunovic



I have been connected with dogs for the majority of my life. My first Chihuahua was from a world famous Italian kennel and with him I started the Kennel name Microschihuas in 1997. Since that time I've won over 30 World and European International and National titles.

I became a judge in 1998 for the FCI group 9. I am now an all-breeds judge and have judged in about 70 countries on all continents including at the prestigious World Dog Shows, European Dog Shows and a Royal Show in Australia. Since 2025 I have been the President of the Toy Club in Serbia, which has organised many high level specialties for dogs from FCI group 9.

#### Luiz Ribas Fernando Silva



As a Judge: Luiz Fernando Ribas Silva was born and has always lived in Curitiba located in the south of Brasil. He became a specialist judge of Dobermann breed by CBKC/FCI in 1982, when he was just 19 years old, which make him the youngest FCI judge to be approved in South America. Twenty years later, in 2002, he became an all breed judge. In the last 40 years he has been judging Specialties and Nationals of Dobermanns in different continents, including he is the first and the only foreign judge (in 100 years) who was elected to judge the Best of Breed at the Doberman Pinscher Club of America National (2024) and also Nationals and Specialties of about 40 other breeds in different countries of all continents,

also important all breed dog shows in Brasil as The FCI World Dog Show (2022) and The FCI Americas & Caribbean Show (2018) and in other 30 countries of all continents.

As a Breeder: He started his Dobermann breeding when he was just 11 years old in 1974, under the suffix of Charleston, and even with an average of just one litter a year, he bred more than 120 champion Dobermanns in Brasil and abroad in 15 different countries, including several in the US and Canada. Dogs bred by him have already won over than 250 All Breed and Specialty Bests in Show in different continents, most of those victories has been acquired breeder-owner handled by Luiz. Dogs bred by him also won Brazilian National Specialties and became top Dobermanns and among all breeds in Brasil in many years. Along with his wife Evelyne, they were awarded as Top Dobermann breeders of the year in Brasil 18 times according to Brazilian national breeders rankings.

### Mathew Morse



Mathew Morse is a highly respected All Breeds Dog Judge based in Melbourne, Australia, with over three decades of experience in the purebred dog world. From early beginnings growing up in Tasmania with the family Corgis, Mathew developed a lifelong passion for dogs which evolved into an internationally recognised career in breeding, exhibiting, and judging. His kennel, Matmor Cavaliers, established in the early 1990s, has produced more than 80 champions in all four colours, including 22 Grand and Supreme Champions. His dogs have consistently excelled at Club Specialty Shows with over 100 Best in Show or Runner-Up to Best in Show awards and countless All Breeds Best in Show wins. However, to win Best in Show at Brisbane Royal recently was an absolute thrill. Another, highlight of his exhibiting career was winning 'Dog of the Year' in 2024.

Mathew has consistently held the title of top Cavalier breeder in Australia since 2016, a significant achievement in a country where the breed is the most popular and competitive within the Toy Group. His international experience includes exhibiting successfully in the United Kingdom, where he lived for several years.

He became licensed to judge the Toy Group in 2004 and achieved his All Breeds judging license in 2015. Since then, he has judged across every state and territory in Australia and has been invited to judge internationally in the United Kingdom, United States, New Zealand, China, Mexico, Brazil, France, Norway, Estonia, South Africa, Thailand, Singapore, Taiwan, and Indonesia. On most of these occasions, he has had the honour of judging Best in Show. Some of his most notable appointments include awarding Challenge Certificates for Cavaliers in the UK, judging wholecolours and Best in Show at the French National, and judging in the USA for numerous Specialty Clubs around the country. A career highlight was in March 2026, when he judged the UK's 'Parent Club Show' —an honour he describes as a lifelong dream.

Mathew believes strongly in contributing to the broader dog world beyond the judging ring. He currently serves as President of the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Victoria and is the Vice President of the Melbourne Dog Club. He is an emcee at the Royal Melbourne Show. In this role, he works closely with media outlets, educates the public, and represents the pedigree dog world in interviews and public appearances.

### Mark Clarke

Mr. Mark James Clarke is an entrepreneur who was born in Northern Ireland and migrated to Australia in 1989. Alongside his parents, Mark bred and exhibited Dalmatians under the Outlook prefix in the UK, Ireland, and Australia. His judging career began at a young age, and he became an all-breeds judge by the age of 39. Born into the world of purebred dogs, Mark has had the privilege of learning to groom, exhibit, and campaign many breeds to championship level. Mark and his wife, Paige, breed and exhibit American Cocker Spaniels under the Staryanks prefix, in partnership with founder and co-breeder Debbie Wilkes. They also breed Miniature Poodles under the Azflex prefix alongside Paige's parents. Over the years, they have achieved significant success with their Dalmatians, American Cocker Spaniels, and Miniature Poodles, combining for more than 350 Best in Show wins across these breeds. Their achievements include success at some of Australia's most prestigious shows, including Best in Show at Spring Fair, Best in Show at Sunbury (the largest one-day show in the country), Reserve Best in Show at the Melbourne Royal, and Reserve Best in Show at the Sydney Royal. Some of their most notable dogs include: • "Ash" (CIB, Supreme Ch Staryanks Stole The Show), winner of 45 Best in Shows and 6 Specialty wins • "Bullet" (CIB, Supreme Ch Azflex Sign Of The Times), winner of 30 Best in Shows and Puppy in Show at the Sydney Royal • "Beastie" (A2O Ch, CIB, Supreme Ch Montaires Beautiful Beastie), breed record holder with 70 Best in Shows and ranked Number One All Breeds (All Systems) in 2023 Mr. Clarke has had the honour of judging extensively across Australia and internationally, including at FCI CACIB shows. In addition to his achievements in the dog world, Mark is an entrepreneur with multiple business interests across Australia and is currently involved in new projects and investments both domestically and overseas.

## WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawals must be made in writing and can be sent via email to [entries@adelaideshowground.com.au](mailto:entries@adelaideshowground.com.au) . Withdrawals must include "Withdrawal" in the subject line and the section (e.g. Dog section), Exhibitor name, class number/s, exhibit number (if known) and exhibit name (if applicable). Withdrawals must be made at least 24 hours prior to judging.

## REFUNDS

No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries. Entry fees are payable and are not refundable in the event of the Exhibit being withdrawn, disqualified, merged classes or the competition cancelled unless otherwise specified by the RA&HS. In the event that the competition as a whole is cancelled by the Society, all entry fees will be reimbursed in full.

## TRANSFER

If an exhibit is entered in an incorrect class, (other than the wrong sex) whether through fault of the intending exhibitor or his agent or otherwise, it shall not be transferred to the correct class after the closing of entries nor shall any refund of entry or registration or other fees be made, but the exhibit shall, if eligible for the open class, be transferred to that class.

If any other inadvertent error or omission is made on the entry form, the entrant may be permitted, at the discretion of the Society, to make corrections.

## REGISTRATION

Prior to entry, all dogs must be registered with their Canine Controlling body in the State or Territory, in which the owner resides and officially transferred to present ownership.

**AND MUST BE UNIQUE.** Use your Surname and numbers in the registration field i.e. Clarke01, Clarke02 for puppies not yet registered. Names of the puppies should also be unique. Completed registration details to be provided as soon as possible. The Baby Puppy will be ineligible to be exhibited if details are not provided prior to the first day of exhibition.

## LOCATION

The Dog Pavilions are located in the North-Western corner of the Showground.  
Only dogs accepted for competition shall be brought onto the Showground.  
Dogs must enter the Showground via the Cooke Terrace Gate off Greenhill Road.  
Cooke Terrace Gate will be open from 7.30 am daily.

## ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

It is a condition of entry that the arrival and departure times set out below will be adhered to.  
Any attempt to deliver or remove exhibits outside of these times, will not be possible.  
Dogs may enter the Showground from 7.30 am and must be benched by 8.30 am, ready for judging at 9.00 am on every day of judging.  
Exhibitor entry via gate 1A is strictly limited from 7.30 am to 9.00 am. Any notifications of late arrivals must be received by 8.30 am. Acceptance will be at the discretion of the Dog Committee. All dogs benched must be brought before the judge for decision.

## REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

Dogs will be permitted to leave at 5.00 pm each day.  
Dogs will be permitted to leave before the stipulated time only with the approval of the Committee and only in exceptional conditions.  
Removal of dogs before the stipulated time of departure will render the exhibitor/s, handler/s, owner/s and dog/s liable to disqualification.  
IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO STAY WITH YOUR DOG/S UNTIL THE STIPULATED TIME OF DEPARTURE, PLEASE DO NOT MAKE AN ENTRY.

## ENTRY PASSES

Exhibitors entering:

- One exhibit to receive one admission pass
- Two exhibits to receive two admission passes
- Three & Four exhibits to receive three admission passes
- Five & Six exhibits to receive four admission passes
- More than Six exhibits; one pass for every other two exhibits entered

An additional pass will be issued by the Show Manager to exhibitors returning for judging on Sunday 13 September.  
Resale of entry passes is not permitted.

## CAR PARK TICKETS

Access for Dog exhibitors to Rose Terrace Car Park 2 will be through a designated Dog exhibitor entry from Rose Terrace. Exhibitors seeking to park a vehicle and a trailer will be directed to Rose Terrace Car Park 2.  
Bookings should be made with entries.  
Cost: Single vehicles \$29, Vehicle & trailer \$58.  
Accommodation will be made for parking for finals on Sunday 13 September and will be made available during the Show but will be restricted as there are only a certain number available. Not all major award winners will be able to be provided with a carpark.

An Australian National Kennel Council Challenge /Best of Breed may be awarded in any breed at the discretion of the Judge. No award will be made unless the exhibit is, in the opinion of the Judge, worthy.

### SPECIALS AWARDS – CONFORMATION JUDGING

1. Judging on Saturday 5 September to Saturday 12 September, will proceed as far as the awarding of "Best Neuter of Breed" "Best Baby Puppy", "Best Puppy of Breed", Best of Breed", "Runner-up Best of Breed" .
2. Exhibits awarded "Best of Breed", "Puppy of Breed", "Best Neuter of Breed", "Baby Puppy of the Day" from each group, must attend and compete in Group Specials on General Specials Day, unless:
  - a) A certificate signed by the owner is lodged with the Society advising that the animal has died, or
  - b) The owner lodges with the Society a veterinary certificate certifying that the dog is unfit for exhibition due to injury or disease, or
  - c) The owner advises of some other cause or reason why the dog cannot be exhibited and which the Society's Dog Committee considers reasonable.
3. Group Specials will be judged on Sunday 13 September at 9.00 am, beginning with Group 3, followed by 1, 2, 4, 6, 5, and 7.
4. All dogs and bitches eligible for Group Specials must be benched by 8.30 am on that day.
5. Benching for ALL Giant Breeds will be allocated on Sunday 13 September.

### BEST OF BREED

Best of Breed awarded (including exhibits excused from exhibiting in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 2, a. to c. "Special Awards", previously) will be available for collection at the Dog Pavilion office on General Specials Day.

Certificates will not be available for "Best of Breed" winners not exhibited in Group Specials, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 2 above.

## PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

Any prize money won during the Royal Adelaide Show is paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). The exhibitor should provide the BSB, Account Number and Account Name at time of original entry.

PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID BY THE END OF OCTOBER.

### PRIZE MONEY AND GST

Prize money as stated in the Prize Schedule does not include GST.

The prize money which we pay to successful exhibitors depends on information provided to us. If you confirm that you are GST registered and provide your Australian Business Number (ABN), we will pay the appropriate prize money plus 10% GST. We will provide you with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice which you will need to submit to the Australian Taxation Office.

If you confirm you are registered for GST, in entering the competition, you acknowledge your agreement to the following:

You will not issue a tax invoice to the RA&HS in respect to prize money received;

You will notify the RA&HS if you cease to be registered for GST.

If you provide your ABN but are not registered for GST, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Prize Schedule without reference to the GST.

If you confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Prize Schedule without reference to GST.

### IMPORTANT

It is important that you either:

Confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, or

Confirm you are entering as a GST registered business and supply your ABN

Failure to do either of the above will require the RA&HS to withhold tax, at the maximum tax rate, from your prize money in accordance with Australian tax legislation.

The RA&HS is not a tax consultant and therefore assumes no liability for actions taken as a result of these guidelines. In any instances where an entrant or sponsor is uncertain of the tax implications of their involvement, they should consult their own accountant or tax advisor.

The Society makes every endeavor to ensure all prizes listed are accurate at the time of publishing. Should a cash prize be withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing, the prize will revert back to the competitions default amount where applicable. Vouchers, product or trophies withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing will not be replaced. It is the responsibility of the prize winner to follow-up with the Society any sponsored prize (cash, voucher, product, trophy) they believe they are entitled to prior to 30 November in the year of the prize being awarded. ## GENERAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show. A copy of the General Regulations can be obtained from the Society's website at [www.theshow.com.au](http://www.theshow.com.au) or from the Society's Administration Office. Exhibitors should note that the General Regulations contain a number of provisions relevant to competitions and this Schedule including but not limited to, offences, penalties, prohibited drugs. As those conditions apply in addition to the regulations contained within this schedule, Exhibitors should familiarise themselves with the General Regulations.

## SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Special Regulations contained within this Schedule are merely supplementary to and subject to the General Regulations.

The members of the Society's Dog Committee shall have the authority to act on behalf of the Society to take any necessary action under these Special Regulations.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

### DOG EXHIBITORS

A Member of the SACA or any interstate Canine Controlling Body, shall in the precincts of an Exhibition

- Promptly clean up and remove all droppings left by any dog under their control; and
- Promptly clean up and remove all rubbish left by that Member/s

### EXHIBITING

The only persons permitted to handle exhibits at any exhibition conducted by an affiliate of Dogs SA are:

1. Members of the Association; or
2. Members of Controlling bodies in the State or Territory in which the person is domiciled.

### BENCHING

1. Exhibits will be placed and shall remain where directed by the Society's Pavilion Supervisor.
2. Exhibit numbers shall correspond with the bench or cage number allotted to the exhibit.
3. Different breeds or variety of breeds, although owned by the same exhibitor, will NOT be benched together.
4. Benching for ALL Giant Breeds will be allocated on General Specials Day.

Bench numbers must not be altered, moved or otherwise interfered with unless approved by the Dog Pavilion Supervisor. No exhibit shall be absent from its bench except with the approval of the Committee.

### POWDER

The use of grooming powders/chalk inside the pavilion is not permitted other than in the designated grooming area.

### LEADS

Dogs must be brought to the Showground secured with a suitable lead no longer than 2m and Owners/Handlers of exhibits shall always maintain control over exhibits during the Show.

### EXERCISE PERIOD

Dogs may be exercised daily during the one-hour lunch break at a time to be determined each day, depending on the progress of judging.

The Dog Pavilion bench area will be closed during exercise periods.

Dogs must be exercised only in the designated areas.

### DISPLAY CARDS

A display card, not exceeding 210 mm x 297 mm (A4 size), showing the dog's name, its breeder and/or exhibitor, may be placed over each exhibit.

No exhibitor will be allowed to display any prize card or ribbon on their exhibit, stall or stand, other than those issued or approved by the Society for the current year.

Any Signage must not exceed 50 cm x 20 cm.

Free standing signage, or any form of advertising/signage other than that described above, will not be permitted.

### TROLLEYS AND GROOMING TABLES

Trolleys and grooming tables are to be kept within the boundary of the bench rails. They are not permitted to be kept in the walkways.

## DEFINITION OF CLASSES

### Baby Puppy Class

Is a class in which only dogs of 3 months and under 6 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete.

### Puppy Class:

Is a class in which only dogs of 6 months and under 12 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete.

### Junior Class:

Is a class in which dogs of 9 months and under 18 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete.

### Intermediate Class:

Is a class in which dogs of 18 months and under 36 months on the first day of the Show are eligible to compete.

### Australian Bred Class:

Is a class in which dogs whelped in Australia on or over the age of six months on the first day of Show are eligible to compete.

### Open Class:

Is a class in which dogs six months of age or over on the first day of the Show.

### Neuter Class:

Is a class in which dogs six months of age and over on the first day of the Show and are registered as a Neuter on the main register are eligible to compete.

## BRED CLASSES

The age of exhibits is calculated to the first day of the Show i.e. Saturday 5 September 2026.

Class 10-Australian Bred Dog, for dogs over the age of six months whelped in Australia on or before 05/03/26

Class 11-Open Dog, for Dogs whelped on or before 05/03/26

Class 18 - Neuter Dog, for dogs over the age of six months whelped on or before 05/03/26 and are registered as a Neuter on the main register

## BITCHES

Class 1a-Baby Puppy Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 5/3/26 and 5/6/26

Class 3a-Puppy Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 5/9/25 and 5/03/26

Class 4a-Junior Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 05/03/25 and 5/12/25

Class 5a-Intermediate Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or between 05/09/23 and 5/03/25

Class 10a-Australian Bred Bitch, for dogs over the age of six months whelped in Australia on or before 05/03/26

Class 11a-Open Bitch, for Dogs whelped on or before 05/03/26

Class 18a - Neuter Bitch, for dogs over the age of six months whelped on or before 05/03/26 and are registered as a Neuter on the main register

## INJURY, DISEASE

If in the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon a dog shall be so injured or be so affected by sickness, disease or other ailment as to warrant its removal, the Society shall be entitled to have the dog removed. Any expense incurred by the Society in respect of such dog shall be debited to the owner.

### Sequence of Judging

As required by the ANKC Regulations the sequence of judging Best Exhibit in Group and Best Exhibit in Show awards shall be in the following order:

1. Best Exhibit in Group, placed in the order 4th, 3rd, 2nd, 1st.
2. Best Baby Puppy in Group
3. Best Puppy in Group
4. Best Neuter in Group
5. Best Neuter in Show
6. Best Baby Puppy in Show
7. Best Puppy in Show
8. Best Exhibit in Show, placed in the order 2nd, 1st

ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 5, Section 5 (effective 1 July 2017)

5.3.7 Where a puppy is awarded Best in Group/Best in Show placing in accordance with 5.3.6 a or d, the highest placed puppy shall be awarded Best Puppy in Group/Best Puppy in show and there shall be no elimination.

This type of judging does not necessarily produce the second, third and fourth best dogs in Group or Show, but rather the four best dogs in the ring from the Best of Breed winners and, in the case of Best In Show, from the Group winners.

Part VIII - Exhibitions Dogs SA Regulations

## BEST OF BREED

The judging of "Best of Breed" and "Runner- Up Best of Breed" will be conducted at the completion of judging each breed daily, in the normal way.

### Best Exhibit in Group

Only exhibits, which have won Best of Breed, shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit in Group awards 1st, 2nd.

### Best Baby Puppy in Group

Only Best Baby Puppy in Group award will be offered. Therefore, only Best Baby Puppy of the Day winners are eligible to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Group.

### Best Neuter in Group

Only exhibits, which have won Best Neuter of Breed, shall be eligible to compete for Best Neuter in Group awards.

### Best Puppy In Group

Only Best Puppy in Group award will be offered. Therefore, only puppies that have won Best Puppy of Breed are eligible to compete for Best Puppy In Group.

### Best Exhibit In Show

Only exhibits, which have won Best Exhibit in Group, shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit in Show awards 1st, 2nd

### Best Baby Puppy In Show

Only Best Baby Puppy in Show award will be offered. Therefore, only Best Baby Puppy in Group winners are eligible to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

### Best Puppy In Show

Only Best Puppy in Show award will be offered. Therefore, only Best Puppy in Group winners are eligible to compete for Best Puppy In Show.

### Best Neuter in Show

Only exhibits, which have won Best Neuter in Group, shall be eligible to compete for Best Neuter in Show.

## DOGS 2026

### RESTRAINT OF DOGS AT ALL EXHIBITIONS

Except as necessary for the proper conduct of an Exhibition as provided in these Rules, all dogs shall wear a slip, an adjustable slip, or fixed collar and a lead no longer than two metres, unless being judged, and be in the control of a responsible person at all times. No dog shall wear a muzzle or head collar in the judging precinct. At an exhibition a head collar shall be attached to a slip or fixed collar.

### ASSEMBLY AREA

No Children under the age of 7 years will be permitted in the Assembly Area.

### FANS

No portable fans are permitted in the judging ring.

## HAZARD REPORTING

Exhibitors must notify the Area/Pavilion Supervisor or the Venue Control Centre immediately of any hazards detected. Hazards are any situation which has the potential to cause:

## INCIDENT REPORTING

## WASTE DISPOSAL

Appropriate warning signs and Safety Data Sheets (SDS) will need to be provided before allowing these materials on site. SDS are to be available onsite and provided immediately upon request by an RA&HS Representative.

## MEDIA COMMENTS

Any public comment on emergencies, incidents or other venue matters should only come from the RA&HS. The key media spokesperson for the RA&HS is the Marketing Manager.

## DUTY OF CARE

It is important to ensure your own safety and that of all other site personnel, visitors and general public at the Adelaide Showground.

All exhibitors have a "Duty of Care" to avoid exposing themselves or other people to situations which could lead to injury. This "Duty of Care" extends to the prevention of damage to property.

## LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

### 1. Release

Entry to and remaining on the Showground is entirely at the risk of the Exhibitor and to the maximum extent permitted by law, the Exhibitor releases the Society (which term includes in this clause the Society's officers, employees, members and agents), from all claims and demands of every kind resulting from any accident, damage or injury occurring at the Showground, and without limitation, the Exhibitor acknowledges:

- a) the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury to or caused by any Exhibit;
- b) the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury to or caused by any Exhibit, his or her family, invitees and Agents;
- c) the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury to a Motor Vehicle or any of its contents whilst it is located on the Showground; and
- d) without limiting Regulations 1 (a), 1 (b) and (c) above, the Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury resulting from the sale, treatment, failure to treat, destruction, disposal or other dealing with any Exhibit, or for loss, damage or injury to any personal belongings, equipment or property brought onto the Showground.

### 2. Indemnity

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Exhibitor must indemnify and keep indemnified the Society and its officers,

employees, members and agents from and against all actions, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, expenses and liabilities including without limitation, consequential loss and loss of profits for which the Society is or may be or become liable in respect of or arising from:

- a) loss, damage or injury to any person in connection with the Exhibit or the relevant Event;
- b) without limiting Regulation 2(a), loss, damage or injury to any other Exhibit or Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees, Agents, or to the property of the Society, or its members, or to the general public, caused or contributed to or by any act or omission of an Exhibit of the Exhibitor or by the Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees or Agents; and
- c) without limiting Regulation 2(a), loss, damage or injury to the Exhibit, or the Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees, or Agents caused or contributed by an act or omission of an Exhibit of the Exhibitor or by the transportation, feeding or housing of an Exhibit of the Exhibitor.

### 3. Removal from Showground

Without prejudice to any other provision in these Regulations, where the Society, its officers, employees, members or agents removes an Exhibit, or causes an Exhibit to be removed from the Showground, the Exhibit is removed or caused to be removed entirely at the risk of the Exhibitor. The person or persons removing the Exhibit will be deemed to be the agent of the Exhibitor, and his or her acts and omissions will be deemed to be the acts and omissions of the Exhibitor.

### 4. Insurance

The Society will arrange Animal Exhibitors Public Liability insurance cover for all Exhibitors of Exhibits being animals. The Exhibitor is bound by the terms and conditions of this insurance and by Statutory Duties as defined under the Insurance Contracts Act (1984). Details of the Animal Exhibitors Public Liability insurance are set out in the Relevant Schedule. The Society does not insure first party loss, damage or injury to Exhibits, and Exhibitors should consider purchasing insurance if required.

### 5. Personal effects

The Society has no responsibility or liability for any loss or damage caused to personal belongings, equipment or property which is brought onto the Showground by an Exhibitor, his or her family, invitees or Agents.

## EMERGENCY INFORMATION

**Emergency information and Emergency Assembly Points for the various animal pavilions and stables will be included with Exhibitor List of Entries and Notice to Exhibitor notifications. Competitors should be familiar with these plans.**

## FIRST AID

During the Royal Adelaide Show, St John provides First Aid Services but it is suggested that competitors have a basic First Aid kit for minor medical requirements.

St John is not in attendance after public hours.

For emergency contact details, check Notice Boards for onsite assistance or dial 000 for a medical emergency.

## RA&HS EMERGENCY FACILITIES

Firefighting and other emergency equipment must not be removed or used for any other purpose. Missing or unserviceable equipment should be reported to the Venue Control Centre immediately.

## SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in designated locations. The Royal Adelaide Show is a smoke free event.

## TRAFFIC CONTROL

The RA&HS Traffic Control Policy imposes speed restrictions within the Showground. For the duration of the Royal Adelaide Show the speed limit is 10 kph on the grounds and 8 kph inside buildings.

The use of vehicles inside the Showground is closely managed during the Royal Adelaide Show. Conditions of entry will be provided with the issue of Vehicle Entry Permits.
