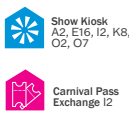
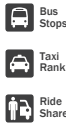

Fleeces will score ½ a point for each tenth of a Micron the S.F. is lower than the mean fibre diameter (M.F.D.). To help reduce the percentage differences between the M.F.D. and S.F. for the Micron grades, the following adjustments to the point scores will be applied.

Comfort Factor

Fleeces are awarded points according to the percentage of Fibres Less than 30 Micron.....**10**

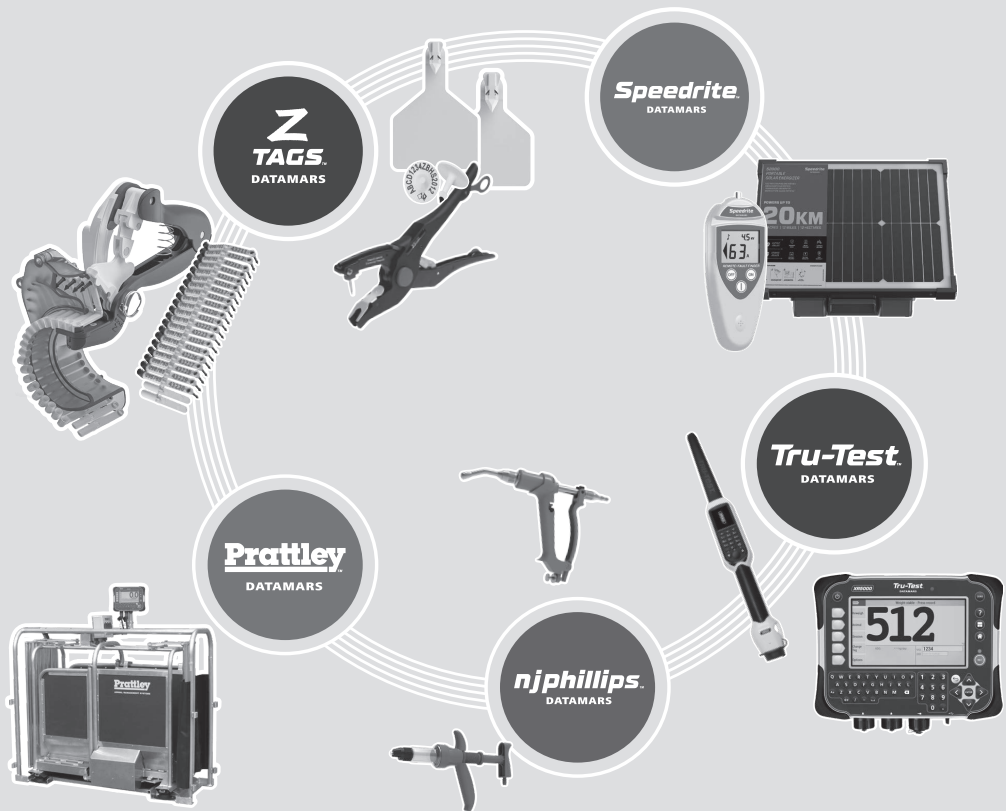
