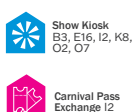
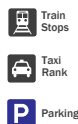

### **Adelaide Showground Emergency Procedures**

- Provide any assistance you can, if safe to do so, until help arrives – Assist injured or people with disabilities
- **Fight the fire** only if it is safe to do so
- **Evacuate the area** if necessary – **DO NOT** re-enter the building or area
- Obey reasonable instructions from official personnel

### **Emergency Assembly Points for Animals**

**Sheep** – Ramps placed at all doors and sheep shepherded to the Main Arena.

#### **Farmyard Nursery & Learning Centre & Farm Expo**

- Large animals to the Main Arena via nearest gate.
- Small animals to other Livestock pavilion via the nearest gate.

**Dogs, Cats & other small animals** – Evacuate the building via the safest route with owner or handler.
